



There are two main types of limited slip differentials, a torque sensitive geared (or clutch pack style) and a viscous type, which is a pump and clutch pack system. Other less used systems are the Helical, torsion type and others.

LIMITED SLIP DIFFERENTIALS

BASIC FUNCTIONS

You're going to want to keep last month's discussion of the parts and function of the open differential in mind while we continue.


Let's first take a closer look at the torque sensitive style which is commonly found in most street sports or road course cars. There are three sub-categories of the torque sensitive/clutch pack style rear end.

- 1. One way lock locks up only on acceleration
- **2.** One half lock locks on acceleration and partially locks on deceleration
- **3.** Two way lock locks up on both acceleration and deceleration

Now let's take a close look at the operation of this type of differential.

The inner splines of the clutch friction discs are splined to the sun (side) gear while the steel plates have ears or tabs that lock into the carrier housing. There is a spring that pushes against the side gear and into the clutch pack. This spring is stacked or installed between the side gear and carrier housing. This arrangement is part of what creates the positive lock-up.

Changing the spring pressure will change how much slippage will be allowed during deceleration or coasting. The other factor that allows for pressure against the clutch pack is created by the beveled gear cut on the sun (side) gear and spider (planetary) gear. Under torque or pressure, a bevel gear set will try to push away from the other gear, so as the spider gear pushes on the sun gear, it creates more pressure to be applied to the clutch pack. This pressure is what allows for some slippage during turns, as the pressure will be different to each sun gear due to the corner radius. This is also what keeps a tire on a slippery surface from spinning, since more pressure will be applied to the wheel on a dry surface, propelling the vehicle forward.




and different wheel speeds/slippage during turns. The wheel with more traction will have even more pressure applied t it from the force of the sun gear and the wheel with less traction will have less pressure applied, stopping it from spinning by allowing some slippage in the clutch pack during turns.

Changing the differential oil—it's one of the mostoverlooked maintenance tasks on any vehicle. Because the differential is at the rear and under the car, it gets none of the star treatment that the engine up front does. However, if lubrication in the differential fails, you won't be getting very far for very long. Fortunately, you only

need to change this oil every 30,000 to 50,000 miles

(as always, check your owner's manual).
