Join us on Saturday, May 21st for our 4th Annual Sporting Clays Shoot off at the Blendon Pines Gun Club. For those unfamiliar with Sporting Clays it is a form of clay pigeon shooting on a course that consists of shooting stations "holes" in natural terrain.



Unlike traditional skeet shooting sporting clays simulates the unpredictability of live-quarry shooting, offering a great variety of trajectories, angles, speeds, elevations, and distances. Please wear appropriate clothing and shoes. Eye and ear protection is REQUIRED. Regular glasses/sunglasses are adequate and they do have some protective eyewear available, but if it's busy they may run out. They also sell earplugs. Guns are available to rent for \$10 (2 people can share 1 gun) and of course ammo is available for sale. The cash cost will be \$22, not including gun (\$10) / ammo (\$6.95/box) - 2 boxes required. Of course you are welcome to bring your own shotgun. For those members that want to accompany another participant, but are not interested in shooting or watching, there is an indoor area available to hang out. 

Spring has sprung and its Porsche time again. This month I thought I'd give you some tips to help with your safety and enjoyment.

SPRING TIME SAFETY AND ENJOYMENT

Before leaving home, always check the levels of your oil, coolant and brake fluid. In addition make sure your tires are properly inflated and check the condition of any belts (if you can see them). I recommend making these checks every 30 days.

Keep your owner's manual in the car; it is full of very useful information such as fuse locations and fuse numbers. Handy information if you have a light not working.

Keep a first aid kit handy. A large kit is not needed but a small kit with items such as band aids, antiseptic, gauze and stretchy medical tape is essential. A good quality roll of tape is useful in many situations and eliminates the need to carry "Duct Tape".

Insurance certificate and registration should always be in a secure but handy location.

Always take a few snack bars, small bottles of water, a warm blanket, napkins and tissues. These items will be a thankful asset in the event of a traffic jam or breakdown.

Other important items are a sharp knife such as a Swiss Army knife, a tire gauge, a short length of rope and if you have room, a can of Fix-A-Flat. A good quality "pocket jump box" can be very useful in the event a light is left on inadvertently. These small boxes which weigh only 2.5 pounds will start a car with a completely dead battery and they hold a charge for months if not used.

Many boxes come with a built-in LED flashlight, an SOS signal flasher and cables to charge your phone, tablet and other such items. The best part is that they can be stored in a very small space and eliminate the need for bulky jumper cables and a separate flashlight.

Take a look at boxes such as these and search the internet for others that you may prefer.


