



A Brief Overview of What Is Involved In Restoring Your Car and Why We Can't Give You A Fixed Price.

## **AUTOMOTIVE RESTORATION**

A THREE PART STORY BY TIM THATCHER - PART 1 OF 3

**Restoration**: the act or process of returning something to its original condition by repairing it, cleaning it, etc.: the act of bringing back something that existed before

By definition, restoration projects are very difficult to estimate because there are so many unknown repairs to be made. Undoubtedly there will be items and areas



that will require repair, that we will be unable to identify until the car is dismantled and reassembled. Therefore, the true cost of the restoration will not be known until the project is complete. Anyone considering an automobile restoration must realize that it is a substantial financial commitment and must be prepared for such an investment. Nationally, the average restoration takes 1000 man/hours with an average cost of \$77.00 per hour.





Ground-Up or often called Off the Frame Restoration is a complete restoration. Our first step with this type restoration will be to completely dismantle your car.

As we dismantle the car, we inspect each part and determine if it can be used again. If it's not in perfect condition it will need to be replaced or repaired. Upon completion the vehicle, test drives are performed to insure that no step has been missed and that the vehicle we deliver to you is one that you can trust to be better than new.

Partial Restoration or "rolling" restoration is the process of restoring one or more aspects or your vehicle. It can include any of the following five main areas: Engine, Suspension, Brakes, Interior, and Exterior.
