BUTTERNUT SQUASH & PEAR SOUP

BY MIKE KARLUK

Ingredients:

1/2 Stick Unsalted Butter

2 Large Onions (diced)

1 Medium Butternut Squash (peeled, seeded, and cut into 1-inch pieces)

4 Medium Fragrant Pears

(3 peeled and chopped into fine pieces, 1 finely diced for garnish)

1 Quart Reduced-Sodium Chicken Broth or Vegetable Stock

2 Rosemary Sprigs

1/2 Cup Heavy Cream

1 Teaspoon Salt

1 Teaspoon Freshly Ground Black Pepper

2 Tablespoons Brown Sugar

Directions:

- 1. Heat the butter in a large pot over medium heat and cook onions until soft and starting to turn translucent.
- 2. Add squash and pears and cook for 5 minutes
- 3. Add Stock. (Ingredients should be submerged in liquid. If not, add just enough water to do so.)
- 4. Add Rosemary, bring to a simmer and cook until squash and pears are very tender, about 45 minutes.
- 5. Remove Rosemary sprigs
- Add Heavy Cream and puree in pot with an immersion blender until smooth or in batches in a blender or food processor.
- 7. Season with Salt, Pepper, and Sugar to taste.
- 8. Place a heap of diced pear in the center of each serving bowl and surround with soup.



Hints:

- 1. I think it works better with Spanish onions or yellow onions rather than sweet onions.
- 2. Put the rosemary in cheesecloth or a cloth spice bag, otherwise, it's murder getting all the rosemary leaves out before you blend it.
- I tend to use a lot of rosemary as I like the flavor and aroma.



A WARM FIRE ON A COLD NIGHT

PORSCHE PURCHASING TIPS

With our cars all tucked away and cold winds blowing, it's not unusual that we dream of the coming driving season, and often dreams of a new ride drift into our minds.

Dreams can be a great way to experience the thrill of driving that car you've always wanted, but let's take a moment to discuss how not to allow your dream to become a nightmare.



Investment

If you are considering a purchase for investment purposes, you cannot beat the 356 and early 911s. The value of each has gone up to the point where most people can no longer afford them and if they do buy one they are afraid to drive it. Many of these cars have gone into private collections.

If you are considering purchasing one of these cars, be very careful. Check the pedigree of the car and if it has been restored, have an expert check for the correctness of the restoration. If it looks like you're getting a good deal, have it checked again. While the market for various cars can sometimes be difficult to measure, I feel these cars may be getting to the top of their value.

Some of the cars which are still going up or holding their value very well are the SC911s and the 3.2 Carreras. The value of these cars has been increasing rapidly, and currently offer the best bang for your money, with potential similar to increase in value. Specialty cars like the GT, RS or Turbo model cars always hold their value better.

Purchase

Looking to purchase a new car? Keep in mind that in the first year most new cars lose 20% of their value and often times higher priced cars can even lose more. In the second year of ownership, the car will continue to lose another 15 to 20% of it's value and you'll wind up with approximately a 35% loss of value by the end of the second year.

I believe the solution to avoid such a loss is as simple as purchasing a 2 year old car. This practice seems a lot more economically sound than buying new. A two year old car will most likely have very low mileage, should still look and smell new and will have plenty of factory warranty left. In addition, with the car well maintained, you should lose no more than 7 to 10% of the purchase value from that point on each year.

The Bottom Line - Getting the Best Bang For Your Buck

Want something newer? It's hard to beat purchasing a two year old car that has been well maintained.

Looking to invest? To find a car that will hold it's own or possibly go up in value without breaking the bank, look at the 3.0 SC, 3.2 Carreras and the last of the air cooled 911s.

Remember, there are no guarantees. All we can do is study history and current trends, then project them out into the future. In the end, we have to balance desire with common sense to end up with a decision we can both afford and live with.

Final Thought

When purchasing a used vehicle it only makes sense to have it inspected by someone familiar with that particular make of car and we share this advice with all everyone we know. Why, then, is this tip so often ignored?

As with any purchase, you best information is to have the service records showing what has been done or what may have been recommended and not repaired.

Because of issues such as these, having a professional perform a PPI is extremely important. Items with wear that need replacing do not make a car a poor purchase as long as you know you're going to have that expense.

Knowing the cost of any necessary repairs provides you with a bargaining chip while discussing your final purchase price. We recommend you add the cost of the repair to the purchase price to determine if you are paying a fair market value for the vehicle.

What should a good used car inspection include? A good inspection will include a system check of all electricals, engine performance, possible leaks, belts, hoses, suspension, tires, brakes, fluid conditions and levels and body integrity and finish.

We hope everyone enjoys a safe winter season, we look forward to seeing you soon.


