ROLLER DERBY

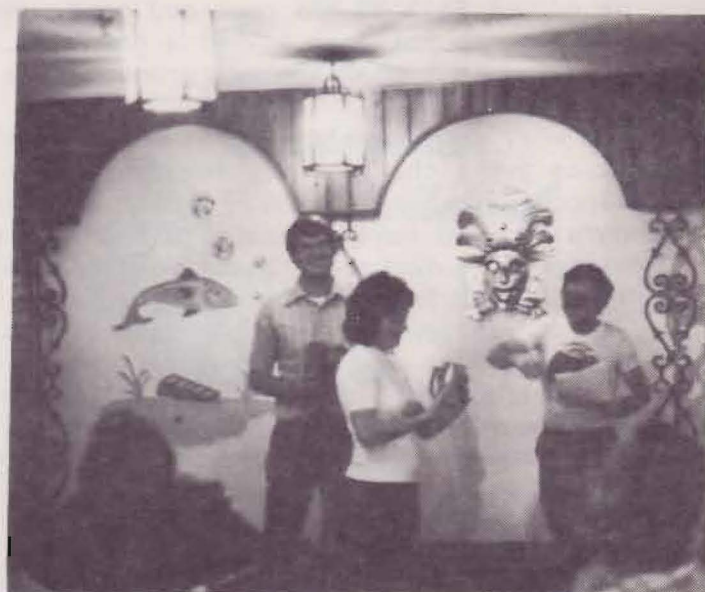

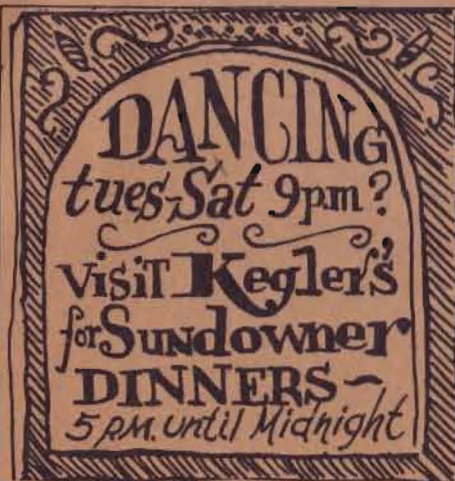

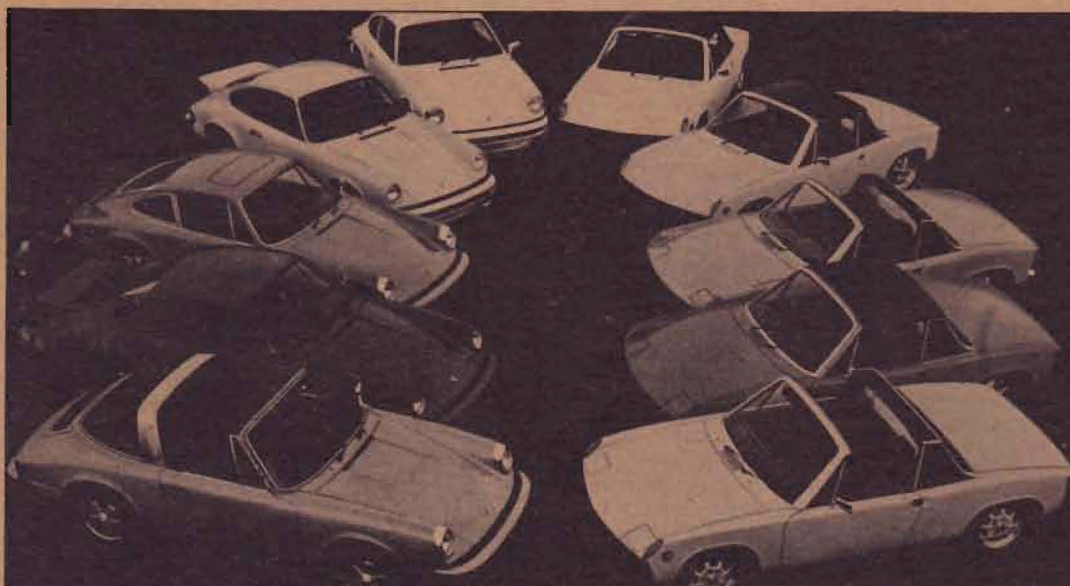
