

BEHIND THE STEERING WHEEL OF PHIL CULL

WE HAVE BEEN BLESSED WITH A VERY ENTHUSIASTIC NATIONAL MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN, BOB RASSA OF COCKEYS-VILLE, MARYLAND. RARELY DOES A MONTH GO BY THAT I DON'T RECEIVE SOME FORM OF INFORMATION FROM HIM.

A RECENT ANALYSIS AND HISTORICAL REVIEW OF THE MEMBERSHIP DATA HAS REVEALED SOME INTERESTING INFORMATION. AS OF FEBRUARY, 1976, MEMBERSHIP STOOD AT 11,869 ACTIVE MEMBERS WHICH REPRESENTS BETWEEN 18,000 TO 19,000 WHEN AFFILIATE AND FAMILY MEMBERS ARE INCLUDED. HISTORICALLY, MEMBERSHIP HAS INCREASED AT A RATE OF 12% PER YEAR, OR AN AVERAGE OF 1% PER MONTH.

WITH AN ADDITIONAL 118 OR SO EVERY MONTH SOUNDING LIKE AN IM-PRESSIVE NUMBER, MANY MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMEN MIGHT HAVE RELAXED.
NOT BOB RASSA, HE DUG INTO IT FURTHER AND DETERMINED THAT JANE NESTLERODE, OUR EXECUTIVE SECRETARY PROCESSES 300 TO 400 NEW APPLICATIONS EVERY MONTH.

THIS REFLECTS A NON-RENEWAL (DROPS) DIFFERENCE OF 200 TO 300. THESE DROPS ARE PCA MEMBERS WHO FOR ONE REASON OR ANOTHER HAVE ELECTED TO NOT RENEW THEIR MEMBERSHIP. THE MOST DISTURBING FACT IS THAT APPROXIMATELY HALF

OF THE ''DROPS'' ARE FIRST YEAR MEMBERS. CAN YOU BELIEVE THAT? TO ME, THAT IS VERY DISTURBING NEWS! WE, THE ''OLD TIMERS'' ARE DOING SOMETHING WRONG.

BOB HAS PROPOSED A ''MEMBER
SPONSOR'' PROGRAM, KIND OF LIKE
A ''BIG BROTHER'' APPROACH SOME
OF US MAY BE FAMILIAR WITH.
THIS PROGRAM IS BEING SUGGESTED
FOR VOLUNTARY INCORPORATION BY
THE VARIOUS REGIONS. AN OUTLINE
WAS HANDED OUT AT THE LAST WMR
BOARD MEETING, AND I ASKED THOSE
IN ATTENDANCE TO READ AND COMMENT ON IT AT THE NEXT BOARD
MEETING, MAY 4TH, AT THE HOEK'S.

IT IS MY BELIEF THAT FOR SOME REASON, THE FIRST YEAR MEMBERS FEEL ''LEFT OUT''. WE ARE NOT REALLY A CLIQUE-TYPE GROUP: IT'S JUST THAT EVERY COMMON BOND OR-GANIZATION HAS A NUCLEUS OF MEM-BERS THAT ''PITCH IN'' AND KEEP THE CLUB GOING. THIS, IN MOST CASES, IS OUT OF NECESSITY RATHER THAN DESIRE. TO INTER-FACE WITH THE DIFFERENT ''WORKER BEE'' TYPE PEOPLE TO MAINTAIN THE BEST INTERESTS OF WESTERN MICHIGAN REGION IS QUITE TIME CONSUMING. EVERY OPPORTUNITY THAT OFFERS A CHANCE FOR EX-CHANGE OF THOUGHTS, IDEAS, ETC. IS MOST GENERALLY UTILIZED.

IF WE HAVE APPEARED TO BE AN ''IN CROWD'' BUNCH, I WOULD LIKE TO HEREBY PUBLICLY APOLOGIZE. IT IS NOT OUR INTENT AS WE ARE INTERESTED IN THE ENTIRE MEMBERSHIP. THE MEMBERS ARE THE CLUB!

WITH A POSITIVE ATTITUDE TOWARD A ''MEMBER SPONSOR'' PROGRAM BEING ADOPTED BY THE WMR BOARD, I WOULD LIKE TO SOLICIT NAMES FOR CREA-TION OF A SPONSOR ROSTER. ANYONE WISHING TO VOLUNTEER FOR BECOMING A SPONSOR SHOULD CONTACT JUDY OR MYSELF. IT IS THE PRIMARY DUTY OF A SPONSOR TO MAKE THE NEW MEM-BER FEEL AS MUCH ''AT HOME'' AND WELCOME AS POSSIBLE. THE SPONSOR WOULD ASSIST THE ''NEWCOMER'' TO BECOME ACQUAINTED WITH PCA, THE WESTERN MICHIGAN REGION, ITS EVENTS, ACTIVITIES AND OPERATION, AND ESPECIALLY THE PRESENT MEM-BERSHIP.

HOPE TO HEAR FROM ALL OF YOU ''BIG BROTHERS'' (AND/OR ''BIG SISTERS'') AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. WE SHOULD GET GOING NOW BECAUSE THE NEW MEMBERS ARE ROLLING IN LIKE CRAZY AND WE'VE GOT A FANTASTIC YEAR AHEAD JUST CHUCKED FULL OF SUPER EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES.


THE EQUIPMENT COMMITTEE REPORTED NO MAJOR INVESTMENTS. STILL WORKING ON INVENTORY.






