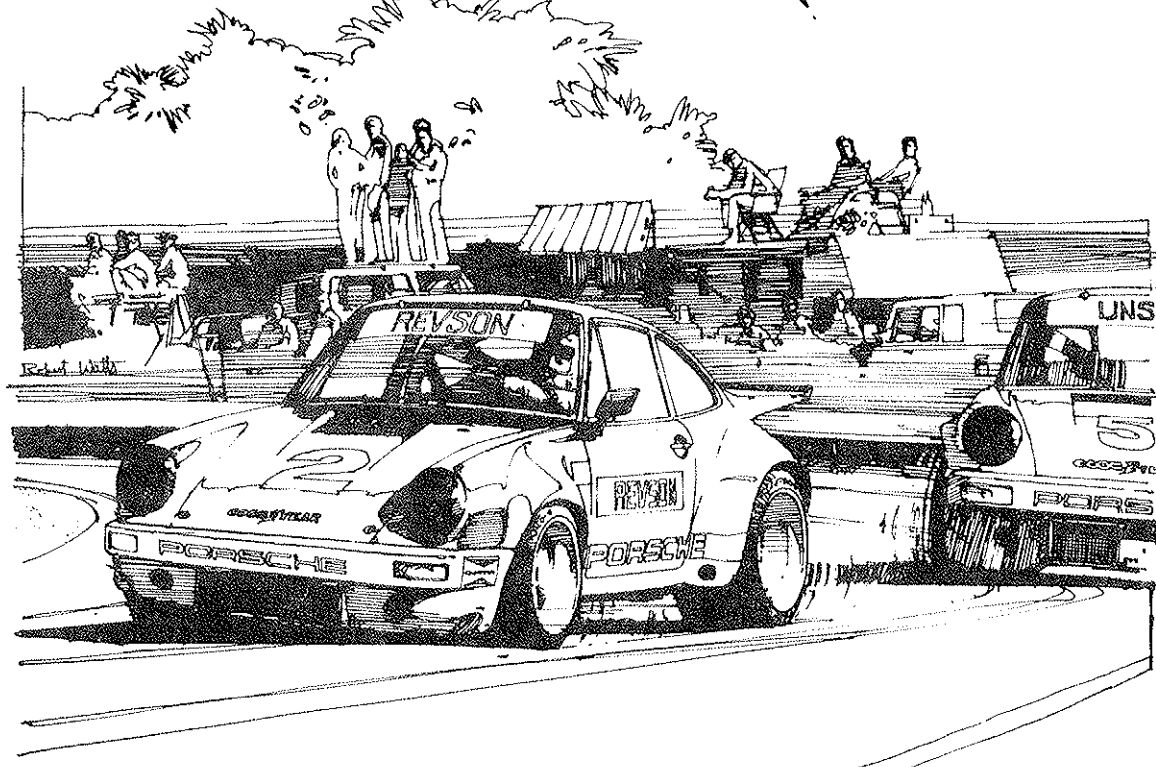

MAKI'N TRACKS

Well Folks, here it is, May of 1979, I thought maybe you might like a little description of our Autocross course that we have set up for the 7th annual Holiday on Wheels since it will not be at the usual Nothdurft Farms. I realize that there are a lot of you out there that really don't care for the average parkinglot type autocross, but unfortunately the insurance situation that has come up at Nothdurft does not leave us with much other choice.

The course at Lear in my opinion can be best described this year in two words, "simple, and difficult".

Simple for one main reason- there is very little memory involved. The course has been set up with a minimal number of pylons, so that you are able to concentrate on how to take the corners, instead of trying to figure

out where the corners are. I've been to a lot of autocrosses where half the day has been spent just trying to memorize the course, and I can guarantee there will be none of that here!

You're not off the proverbial hook yet however, the difficult driving aspects of the course have been somewhat increased to compensate for the small amount of memory required. I can assure you that there will be at least one open corner down and back type turn, a double pylon chicane, tossed in for good measure, and an in line pylon decreasing chicane also. As far as speed is concerned, you can expect mostly mid-range second for most of the course, with just a touch of third down the back stretch.

Tech inspection will be a tough one, so please be prepared, Helmets, and

seat belts are also a requirement for this event. We're going to start a little early this year so that you can just about plan on a good five or more timed runs. Registration will open at 8:00 and run until 10:30. Tech will be open from 9:00 till 11:00, with practice runs starting at 10:00. Timed runs will start at noon.

There will be carbonated beverages available at the site, however there are no plans for food, so please plan accordingly. If there is anything I missed, please feel free to give me a call at work or home (541-6663; 9421339), and I really hope to see you there.

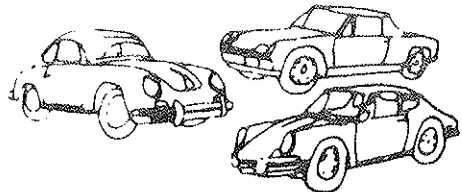

post script I would like to cover PCR requirements for clothing they recommend be worn by all participants in a driving event.

"Full length pants, long sleeved shirts and socks of non-synthetic material are recommended for all drivers. Driving suits or fire resistant clothing and gloves are highly recommended. Full shoes are required. No bare

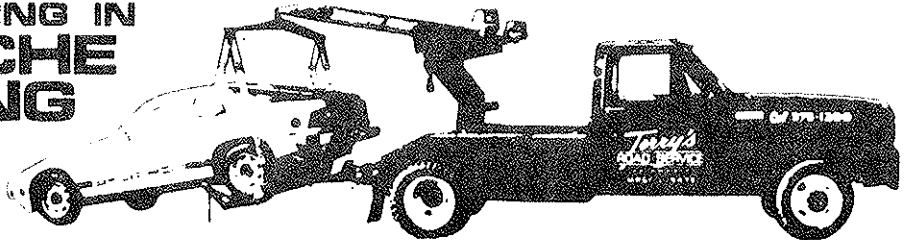
feet, sandals, or open-toed shoes are permitted. Driving shoes are recommended." Now we of IROC have not chosen to strictly enforce the PCRs; however, we would strongly recommend that you follow these regulations for clothing. The reasoning is very simple---FIRE!! If you're ever in a situation with the potential of fire

lurking among resulting possibilities it might be wise to have adhered to PCR recommendations as synthetic materials tend to melt and stick to a burn. Cottons do not melt and are easier to remove from the burn. I know this is a gruesome but remember it's your hide. The ruling on shoes is self explanatory, the possibility of getting your sandal caught in the pedals is not very remote, not to mention the exposed skin in case of fire.

Finalt, we strongly recommend everyone participating in a driving event carry liability insurance on their car. If you don't your butt is just waiting for the hand of reality to give it a healthy smack! I don't want to bore you with all these recommendations, it's just that we all like to do what we're doing and we don't want to see anyone get hurt. So come on out

and compete, and let's have a fun, safe and successful IROC this year!
