


Both Grattan and Ionia are within bout a half hour drive of Grand Rapids. So don't let those opportunities slip by.




### IROC - "1981" GRATTAN'S BACK

Western Michigan Region (WMR), Motor Stadt Region (MSR) and Michigan Indiana Region (MIR) will tri-sponsor an IROC event at Grattan Raceway this year. The Grattan event will be MSR's and MIR's IROC event for the series. There will be no IROC at Plymouth or Owosso Speedway this year. The IROC series for 1981 will be a three event series. The over-all winning region champion will still be based on a percentage of participation from each region for each region to win the traveling trophy. For overall class champions, overall class trophy's will be based on competing in more than one individual event up to three events. Example ---- two 1st's would qualify you (200 points) but three 2nd's could win your class for the overall (80 points x 3 events = 240 points). This should increase participation plus you only have three weekend expenses out of town this summer to run in IROC. The three events for IROC this summer will be:

ROAD AMERICA May 23/24
GRATTAN June 27/28
IONIA Sept. 20

Grattan is a 14 turn, 1.8 mile, very challenging road course. It will be a big plus to the IROC series. This year IROC will be a better auto-x-ing series, so come out and support your local region.


