



given for 2nd and 3rd place. Paul & Marci can relax - we won't tell where the items came from.

Concours Guidelines 1985

I.	GENERAL
1.	CILITERIAL

A. Only members will be eligible for trophies.

II. CLASSES

The entrant will be the sole judge of which logical class his car belongs to on the basis of its preparation.

- A. The classes shall be as follows:
 - CLASS A 250 points Exterior - Interior - Trunk - Engine -Undercarriage
 - CLASS B 200 points Exterior - Interior - Trunk - Engine
 - CLASS C 150 points Exterior - Interior - Trunk
 - CLASS D 100 points Exterior - Interior
- B. Any Porsche may be entered in any class as the owner chooses. No other designations will be made with respect to models, years, etc.
- C. In all cases, it shall be required that TWO (2) cars are necessary to form a class. In the instance where insufficient numbers of cars are available to form a class, combinations of classes will be affected as follows:

CLASS A -

CLASS B - to be combined with CLASS A

CLASS C - to be combined with CLASS B

CLASS D - to be combined with CLASS C

No other combinations of classes will be available.

III. SCORING

A. Each car will have the maximum points in its respective class until judged. Points are to be subtracted for deficiencies. Maximum points within each division are shown as follows:

c. The specific use of non-factory replacement parts, and/or accessories, will not in itself become cause for a reduction in points. The parts in question will be judged on the same basis as the rest of the car.

4- 5 cars...... 2 trophies 6- 7 cars..... 3 trophies 8- 9 cars.....4 trophies 10-12 cars..... 5 trophies 13-15 cars...... 6 trophies

In addition to the point system specified by the PCA/WMR region, the following criteria for age points shall apply:

AGE: One point per year after the first three model years to a meximum of ten points. 1985/1984/1983 = 0 points. 1982 = 1 point, 1983 = 2 points, 1980 = 3 points, 1979 = 4 points, 1978 = 5 points etc.

IV. SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR 13th HOLIDAY ON WHEELS CONCOURS EVENT

- A. At this annual event, it is necessary to provide a method of overall scoring which allows combining of three event (concours, Rallye, Autocross) scores to determine the recipient of the Uber Alles Award for Excellence.
- B. Only those cars entered in Concours ClassesA or B shall be eligible for the Uber Alles Award. Classes C and D are not eligible and will not be scored for overall.
- C. Only those Class A or B cars entered for overall will be scored for overall.
- D. All overall entries from Classes A and B will be awarded overall points by the following method:

- = Percentage of Attainment Available Points

The car with the highest percentage of attainment will be the overall Concours winner and will be awarded 100 overall points. All remaining overall entries will receive proportional overall points based on percentage of attainment.


