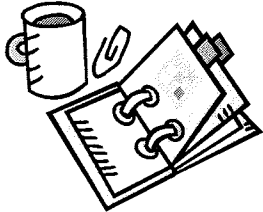

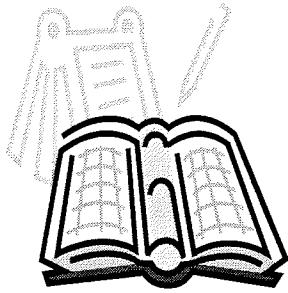

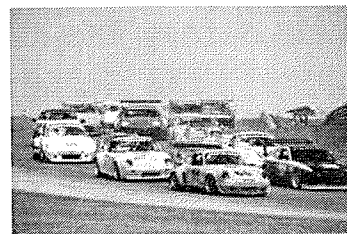

NEW BUSINESS:

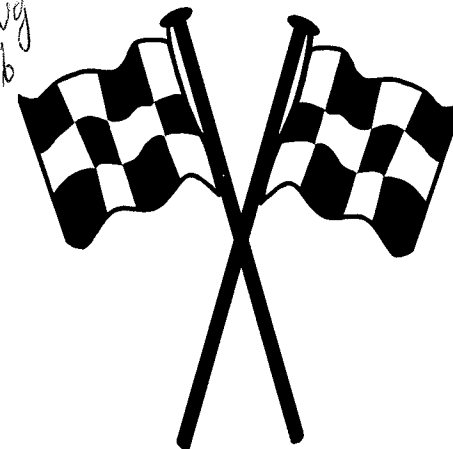
March Dinner Drive: Cascade Roadhouse March 15th. Hosted by Kurt Wirth. Details on the Web and in the newsletter.

So, I was more than pleased when I found out that Acme Industries of Kissme, Florida has come up with a nifty bogus ignition key hoe you can install on the right side of your

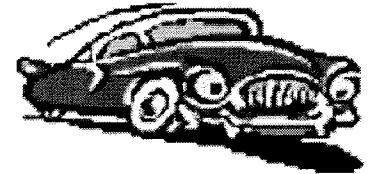

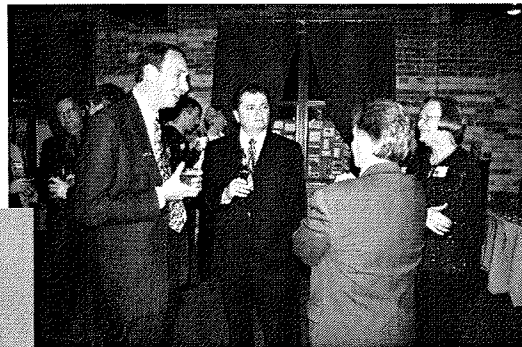

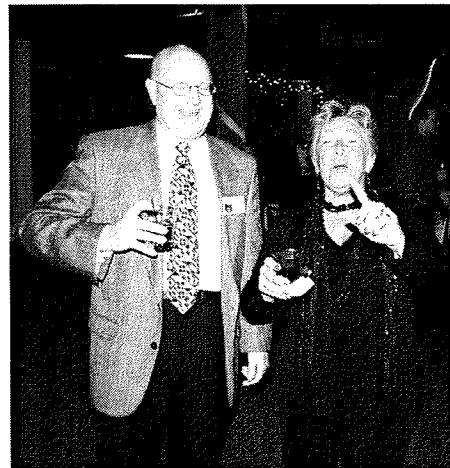
