Do ya wanna PorschePlatz? It's that time to do the Zone 4 Porscheplatz!

The Porscheplatz, (or Porsche Owners Corral) is a benefit to Porsche owners - sponsored by Porsche Cars North America and Porsche Motorsports, in cooperation with the International Motorsport Association (IMSA) and the American Le Mans Series. It provides Porsche owners a designated secured parking area and much more during the weekend Le Mans Events. The first Zone 4 hosted corral is scheduled for **July 17 – 19** during the **Acura Sports Car Challenge** at Mid-Ohio. The second Zone 4 hosted Porscheplatz is just a short drive away at the **Belle Isle Detroit Sports Car Challenge** scheduled for **August 29 – 30**.



DRIVER'S EDUCATION - TRY IT, YOU'LL LIKE IT! PART TWO by Valerie Roedenbeck, Rally Sport Region

HEAD OUT THIS SUMMER!

Attending at least one DE with your Porsche (no matter what year or model) is highly recommended, even if you don't aspire to become a race car driver. A DE will give you the opportunity to experience why, beyond their beautiful shape, Porsches are some of the most revered sports cars in the world. You can spend a lifetime driving around town and on the highway and never quite experience the limits and cornering ability of your car. You can speed on a straight road, but never experience the car's true braking power and acceleration out of corners. A DE won't only make you a more confident driver, but an even more reverent Porsche lover.

Some of you may not yet own a Porsche, but don't let that deter you from participating in a DE. I've seen many different cars at DEs, including Ford Focus, VW Jetta, BMW sedans and even a Honda Odyssey (being tested by engineers). The first time I attended a DE, I was the very proud owner of a new VW Golf. It still had my bike rack on it (guys there called it an "air brake") and I had to take the plastic wheel covers off before my run. Everyone was nothing short of friendly and encouraging as I experienced driving faster for the first time. On my last event, a guy was driving his wife's Lexus sedan because his own car was out of commission. Guys at the track ribbed him ("don't forget to take the lipstick out of the car!") but he held his own and had a great time.

The only negative aspect of attending a DE is that you'll find yourself thinking about the line and a turn's apex on your way to work. For days after, you'll process what you've learned. And if you're like most Porsche lovers, you'll be back. See you at the track!

Cheat Sheet: A Typical Novice DE Day

Night before: complete medical form, look over tech inspection. Pick out long pants and long sleeve tee (cotton only). Pack plenty of water for a busy day outside. Refrain from having one too many drinks, or else hot laps with your instructor will NOT be fun! (Based on personal experience, instructors aren't too keen on you getting sick in their car!)

7:00 AM: **Head to the track**, find a comfy parking spot (tip: try to find a shady spot). Remove all loose items from your car (this includes loose floor mats, decorative items, air fresheners, Celine Dion CD, umbrellas, stuffed animals, workout bag, etc). The glove compartment and trunk should be empty as well. (My brother once "borrowed" his wife's new M5 for a few laps. She didn't have time to empty the trunk and when he returned, there were Goldfish and sippy cups e-v-e-r-y-w-h-e-r-e!)

7:30 AM: **Tech inspection**. Look for the line of cars near the registration table. Bring your completed tech inspection form. (Your mechanic or dealer should complete this form a week or two *before* you head to the track.) Club volunteers will look over your form, ensure there are no loose items in your car, check your helmet (unless you're borrowing one from the club) and give you the OK to complete registration.

7:45 AM: **Registration**. Head to the registration table where you will receive a packet containing instructions, a schedule of events, a tee-shirt, car number decals and loaner helmet (if you requested one). Apply the number decals to the upper center of your windshield. (No worries, Porschephiles—they come off very easily).

8:00 AM: **Mandatory driver's meeting**. Here's where you meet your instructor for the day (or weekend) and get basic instructions regarding event flow and use of the track.

9:00 AM: Day starts. Generally, beginners (novices) will head to the classroom first.

10:35 AM: **Line up**. Hop in your car, secure your helmet nicely (ask your instructor to check you if you're not sure). Head over to where the cars in your run group are lining up. Your instructor will find you among the lineup and hop in.

10:40 AM: Novices on the track. Relax, listen and have fun!

12:30 PM: Lunch. Drink lots of water! Keep the meal light if you have queasy stomach (see footnote 1).

1:30PM, 3:30 PM: **Novices on the track**. Each time you get behind the wheel the track should feel more and more familiar, and you should notice improvements. If there's a classroom session between run times, do attend and ask lots of questions.

4:30-5:00 PM: End of the day. Thank your instructor and head home (or, if this is a two-day event, on to the social events).

Grattan is one of the finest road courses in America. It is located only 20 minutes northeast of Grand Rapids. The 2-mile course is winding, hilly and has a complex assortment of almost every conceivable corner imaginable. The 10 turns include both uphill ascending and descending radius turns, a flat out dog-leg off the 160 degree hair-pin turn, a hidden apex, a Monza bowl, "S" turns, and even a downhill reverse-camber turn. It has been said that if you can master Grattan, you can drive anywhere! It also allows spectators the most viewing surface to watch, with 90% of the racetrack visible from one seat.

If you are new to road courses, you will experience first-hand how to manage your high-performance automobile in a controlled, closed environment and acquire skills that will enhance safer vehicle operation in everyday driving conditions. Each novice will be assigned an instructor and will be a Drivers' School Participant.

The event format is as follows:

Friday, September 19 is set aside for ADVANCED Drivers' Education only. Prior track experience, either at Grattan or other tracks, is required. NO EXCEPTIONS! Novices are welcome to help – and will benefit from learning more about the track.

<u>Saturday</u>, <u>September 20 and Sunday</u>, <u>September 21</u> will be Drivers' Education with full instruction and professional corner worker support. Novices will begin each day with DRIVER'S SCHOOL before starting track activity with assigned instructors. Saturday night, the <u>Western Michigan Region PCA</u> invites you to join us for a TRACKSIDE BANQUET.

<u>Sunday September 21</u> will complete the Driver's Education instruction at noon, followed by TIME TRIALS in the afternoon. All experienced drivers are welcome to participate. Drivers with no track experience prior to this event are not eligible for time trials.

During lunchtime on Saturday and Sunday, we will have low-speed TOURING around the track. The "cost" is a \$20 donation, which will be given 100% to the designated WMR Grattan Grand Prix charity. Lunch is available at the track on all three days.






