



MORPCA Instructor National Accreditation

July 10, 2009 Putnam Park

Instructors: if you're looking for a chance to rub shoulders with your counterparts from our surrounding regions, this may be for you. This sounds like a fantastic experience, and I encourage all WMR instructors to consider this opportunity. Terry

MORPCA will be holding an instructor Class on Friday July 10th at Putnam Park. The format will be generally as follows: the class will be divided into two groups: Mentors and Candidates.

The more experienced instructors will be mentors, paired with a candidate. (Both mentors and candidates will be accredited). The program will be divided between in-class instruction and on track instruction. Four on-track sessions we be held through the day. The Mentor will be doing the driving (at a D student level and speed).

The program will end around 3:15 p.m. Instructors will be given open track for the rest of the day to blow off a little steam.

Instructors will be asked (not required) to instruct over the weekend on Saturday and Sunday during the regular DE.

Cost for the class \$150.00. This includes all 3 days. We expect to include a shirt and food (this is not confirmed yet because we do not have all our cost

calculated, but I would expect something more than just admission.) The size of this class will be limited by the size of the class room facilities at Putnam. We have already had enough people respond indicating they are "interested" to fill this class if they register. We expect that we will have a wait list. Therefore, if this is something that you want to do, I would recommend that when registration opens you respond promptly.

Registration will open on Monday May 11th and will close on Monday June 8th or as soon as the class is full.
