A Special TechSpalte: Tires for your Porsche

Several people have asked me lately about tires for their Porsches, and I wanted to give a quick primer.

First, Porsche owners need to understand N-specification tires. Porsche works with tire companies side-by-side during a vehicle's development to tune the vehicle to a specific tire, and vice-versa. Tires that have gone through a full product development process and meet Porsche's standards for durability, noise, hydroplaning resistance, high-speed handling, and so forth are given an N-rating. The first generation of a new tire design would be designated N-0. A new version of the same tire that has been re-certified would recieve an N-1 designation, and so on for each new generation of a given tire design. Tires without an N-rating will work on your car, but they may not meet Porsche's exacting performance standards, nor will they be tuned to work as harmoniously with your vehicle. Tire manufacturers adjust materials and construction during the development process, including subtle changes to tread compounds, and they may actually sell the 'exact' same tire both with and without the designation - and there will be differences between them.

While it's recommended that you use N-rated tires, it's not mandatory. So what works best? In my personal opinion, Michelin N-rated tires are simply the top of the heap - they score highly in all categories. Pirellis are great tires, but they tend to wear a bit more quickly for some reason. Bridgestones, Continentals, and Yokohamas are a good bet, but I've found that Kumho tires would wear strangely on the Boxster, giving off lots of noise and vibration toward the end. A great value for us has been the German-made Dunlop SP9000. These have been great tires for us, with outstanding wet handling, noise, wear, and traction characteristics, and only \$200 each for rears vs. \$300 for Michelins or Pirellis.

Lastly, have your alignment checked and tuned as necessary. My 996 C4 had a -1.0 deg camber spec (+/- 0.5 deg), which gave instant response, but chewed up the inside edges fast. I had the dealer re-align the rears from -2.0 deg to -0.5 deg (min but within spec), and my tire life went from 6,000 miles to about 15,000 miles with the same driving habits. That's still an expensive oil change for a 996, but at least I didn't smell burning rubber every time I got out of the car anymore.




