
If you wish to participate, here is the weekend itinerary:

TechSpalte: How to Keep Your 2.5L - 3.4L Engine from Becoming a Chocolate Factory

Don't let your engine become a mixer.

We have all heard of the problems incurred with the 2.5 - 3.4 Porsche cooling systems. This month's article will be a general discussion of one of the most common problems, oil and water mixing together.

Fortunately, oil and coolant do not mix well, and as a result leaves certain signs that can alert you of problems occurring. There are two things you can look for.

- 1. One can be found when checking the oil level or while changing the oil. If you perform either of these operations and the oil on the dipstick or the oil you drained is a brown chocolaty color, chances are you have coolant in your oil.
- 2. If, while checking your coolant level you notice either balls of oil floating or an oil scum line around the reservoir, then oil is getting into your coolant system.



This mess was in every part of the cooling system and resulted in a complete system disassembly. The heater core and radiator had to be replaced.

There are three primary causes for these conditions.

- 1. Damaged Oil Coolers Coolers are like small radiators that mount on top of your engine and have both oil and coolant circulating through them.
- 2. Cracked Cylinder Liners A condition often caused by the normal expansion, contraction and vibration of the engine. (We cannot blame Porsche for the design, can we?)
- 3. Cylinder Heads or Gaskets Head gaskets are very robust and rarely fail. Cracks in cylinder heads or head gaskets are most likely caused by an engine that runs too hot.

We have all heard the stories regarding these engines and how they become damaged due to the coolant and oil mixing, but what do we do if we own one? How can this problem be avoided if possible?

Here are some basic rules that may help you avoid a burned-out engine due to this problem:

- USE YOUR TEMP GAUGE! Make sure your gauge reads within the normal operating range. (Any unexplained change in the normal position of the pointer can be an indication of trouble.)
- Keep road debris out of your radiator and connecting ductwork.
- Check your coolant level regularly.
- Repair any coolant system problems right away.
- Do not drive your car if the engine is overheating. Have it checked out to prevent further damage.

So thick it would not flow out on it's own. This car was driven far too long without the problem being checked and corrected.

If you own one of these cars, don't panic. Enjoy driving it, but stay alert to any potential problem.

I have been asked if regularly changing the coolant would be wise and possibly prevent this problem. Porsche says it's a "life-time" coolant and seeing that a 3.4 holds 6.6 gallons of coolant, at \$36.00 per gallon, it's a lot of expense to change it. I would recommend that you have the PH level checked every year. If the PH gets too far off, then you may want to change it or add an additive to correct the PH level.

Next month we'll discuss a variety of topics pertaining to used car purchases, such as buying on eBay, out of state purchases, Carfax, used car inspections and more.
