

A Summer of Fun at the Track

Since it is always nice to share good experiences, I am writing this story about 2011, a year of lots of fun and travel to race tracks that were new to Helen and me. We decided that we would visit three new tracks this year. Our targets were Mid-Ohio, Road America and Nelson Ledges. I could not find a date that worked for Nelson Ledges so Putnam Park was the third track. It was a good choice as it is a fun track and the facilities are really nice.

We sort of started the year in February at Sebring where I helped as a corner worker for club racing and advanced solo. You really get a whole new perspective when you are watching for contact between cars, fluid leaks and safety issues. We also drove the long course in our Cayenne during touring laps. Now I want to do the advanced solo some time. We got to spend some time with Claudio, Brenda and Rick Riley. The weather was great, and watching night races from the hotel balcony is a neat experience.

In April, we added a new R&R aluminum trailer and a tow vehicle to our inventory. After extensive research of new vehicles made in America, the obvious choice was a Cayenne S. It has worked perfectly for us, and can pass anything on the road except a gas station.

Warming up for the summer of travel were track days at Gingerman on April 23 and May 14. June 11 and 12 were track days at Grattan with NASA. I moved to the HPDE 1 group this year and it was a new experience with passing anywhere but braking zones. Each session was followed by a meeting with instructors to point out the good, the bad and the ugly. Only one bad for me. I thought I could complete a pass before turn 1 and ended up passing going into the turn. Not good as that is a braking zone. A mild slap on the wrist and back to the track. On Sunday during my first warm up lap I noticed the temp gauge was now reading nothing. No way was this right. I pulled into the grid and raised the hood to see if a wire was loose. If you have seen the engine compartment on a 2004 C4S, you will know why the grid worker came over and said "Good Luck". My day was over and the next week a new sending unit was installed. Problem solved.

June 25 was another fairly uneventful day at Gingerman. Terry, Ola and Ted were also there and we had some good fun chasing each other around the track. That day Ola found out that coolant spilling onto his tires was not a good thing, and was thankful for the free towing on his insurance.

Now the fun really starts. Helen and I left for Mid-Ohio on June 30 for a three day weekend with the Audi Club of America. I volunteered to be an instructor so I was able to be on the track on Friday. Since it was my first time at Mid-Ohio, a driver in a 944 was nice enough to take me on several laps early in the morning. On Saturday, I got there early and by coincidence hitched a ride with my student to go on the track. He had a 2009 Carrera S, and later said, "You instructors are really trusting. Getting in a car that will do 180 with a perfect stranger." I guess I never looked at it that way. I later rode several hot laps with Cole Carter, one of the instructors at the Mid-Ohio School. Mid-Ohio is a perfect venue for viewing cars on the track, and we spend many hours at different locations watching and learning. We will be returning to Mid-Ohio in 2012. Helen did a great job of finding back roads for us to explore in Ohio as well.

On July 10 we set off for Road America at Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin. There was plenty of parking, and tents were set up for a vintage car show the next weekend – which they were gracious enough to let us use, so we had shade both days. The track is basically 3 long straights connected by some curves over a distance of 4+ miles. You need good brakes if you are going to be aggressive. We have photos of 3 cars that pushed too hard. It is sad to see a Porsche destroyed when it loses a battle with the barrier.

I noticed at mid-day that one front tire had cords showing. I was not too happy since the Sport Cups did not have that much use on them. It is time for some new suspension and camber settings. There was a tire service truck, so I told Helen that I was going shopping. Four new Hoosiers later I was back on the track. Helen said later that she though I meant I was going shopping for a t-shirt. This is another track where you can drive close to almost any corner and have a great view of the track. Also, this is a neat touristy area with many places to visit and enjoy. We had a great time, and look forward to a return visit.

August 12 was closer to home, at Ken Grabowski's annual track day. What a great day with some great drivers. Thank you Ken for the ride in your Radical. That alone made the day special. We spent September 10 and 11 at the WMR DE at Grattan. Another fine event, thanks to all the volunteers. I got plenty of track time with two students. I also wore out the Hoosiers and put a set of used Sport Cups on for the next event. We then drove to Indianapolis on September 15 for a weekend at Putnam Park. We had a great relaxing dinner with some friends who are also in the steel business, and a great weekend instructing at this beautiful track.

I closed out the year at Grattan with the Lotus Club. It was a fun weekend and a good way to cap a fun year of driving, touring, meeting new people and making new friends. It is true, "It's not the cars, it's the people". See you in the spring!!



TechSpalte: Think Spring! It's Almost That Time...

Itching to fire up that precious metal? Here are a few tips for what to do before starting the engine and going for a drive:

- Check the engine bay, looking for any sign of visitors. On older 356 models and with the engine switched off, reach behind the fan shroud area to make sure there is nothing in the fan area. Check your car's fluid levels, including engine oil, coolant, and brake fluid. Then check your air filter if possible.
- If everything looks good, key the engine and crank it over a few times. If it starts right away, it's a good idea to shut it off and check around the engine area again, paying special attention to the fuel lines.
- Carefully look under the car for any signs of fuel, oil or coolant leaks as a result of the start. The initial pressure applied to fuel and oil lines on start up can cause them to split open if they have a weak spot. It's important to recheck them after a brief warm up.
- On the old carbureted cars, gaskets and banjo fitting seals love to leak when they dry out over winter. You may need to let them set awhile after cranking, to let them swell up before running.
- Be sure to check the tire pressures and hit the brake pedal to make sure it's up before taking that first ride.
- Last thing, check your lights, including your brake lights to make sure they are all working properly.

If your battery has given up the ghost over the winter months and you're going to replace it yourself, please use caution. The battery must be reconnected properly. All too often wires are reinstalled incorrectly, creating a potentially dangerous and expensive situation. The accompanying photos show a common result: a fried alternator!

from the old days. Oil companies have reduced the zinc and phosphorus content of motor oil to the point that it no longer protects the older pushrod, flat tappet engines. Why did they do this?
