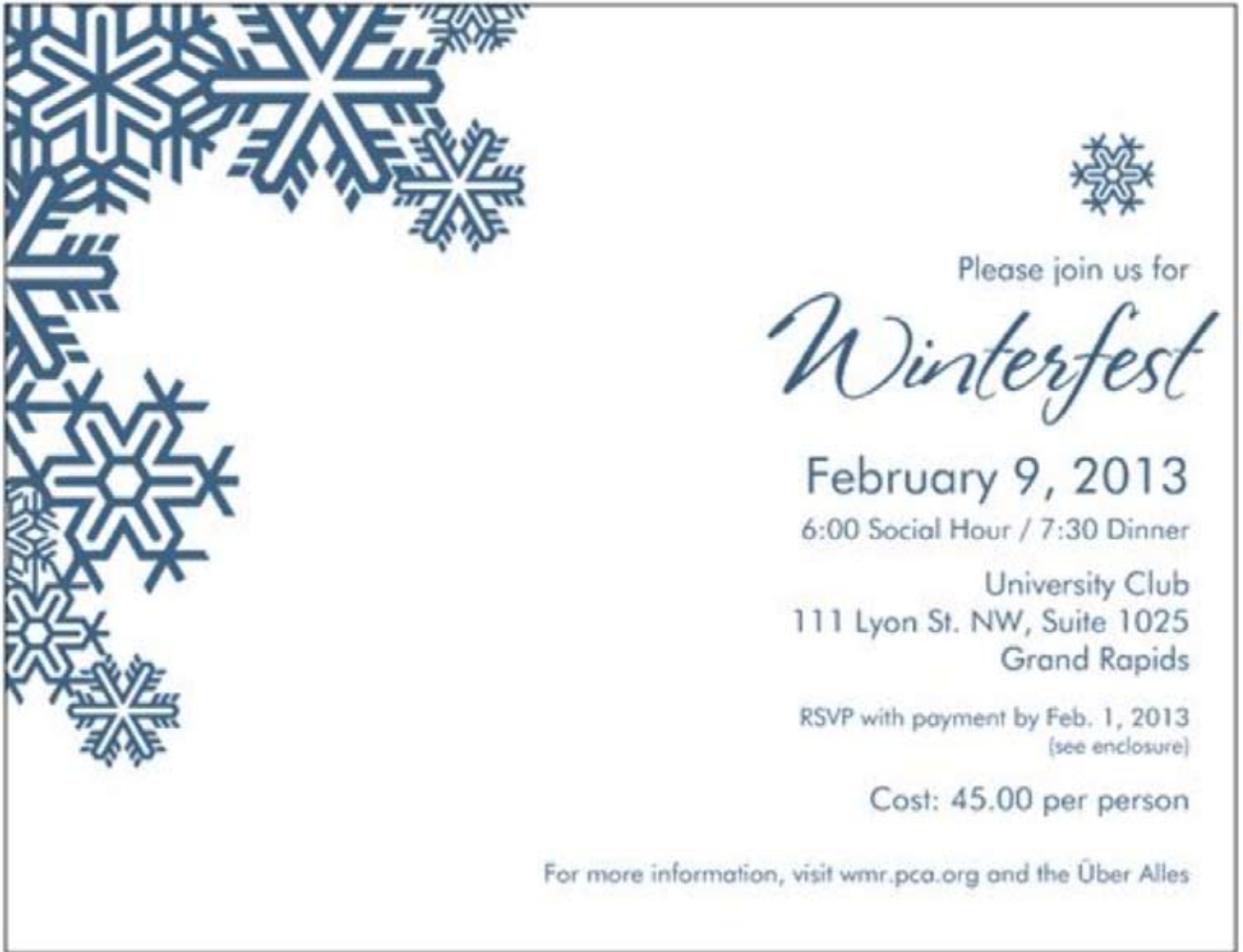

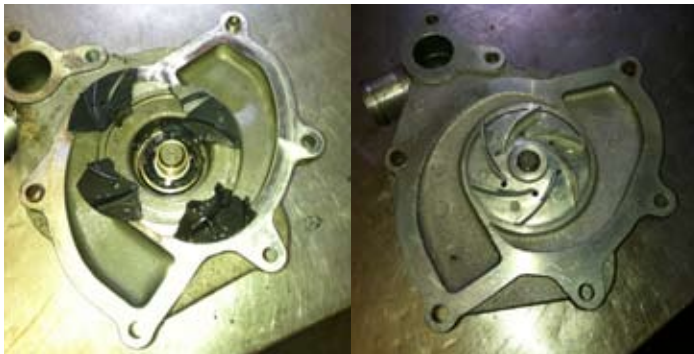
# TechSpalte: Plastic parts! What were they thinking?

LAST MONTH WE TALKED ABOUT belts, hoses and plastic connectors, and how they are affected by chemicals and electrolysis. Well, while recently working on a Boxster, I was reminded of another bad idea: using plastic for the impeller in the water pump!

In the past, Volkswagen used this technology and we had an abundance of water pump replacements due to the impeller coming lose from the shaft. While loose, it either wouldn't spin or it would break completely off and restrict the flow of the coolant.

For some unknown reason, Porsche engineers thought it was a good idea also and used this technology on some of their water pumps. The problem is, as our customer found out, you have no warning of these failures. As a result, we use pumps with metal impellers whenever we replace a water pump. Thanks to all the engineers out there who provide me with job security.

One other item of interest that we found lately was on a car that at times would not start. When we checked the battery and charging system, it all checked out okay. Yet, even though there was no draw down on the system indicated, every once in a while it would not crank. Upon further

investigation, we found that the battery shut-off switch was not making proper contact, resulting in it arcing where it made contact. Additional damage was done as it burned the area where it tightened down.

While inspecting a new shutoff switch, we found small burrs left from the manufacturing process, where the screw makes contact with the base. I recommend that if you are using one of these switches, that you remove the burrs on the hex portion of the screw with a file. This will allow the screw to have a full and complete contact with the base and prevent a future failure.

Here is another maintenance item that is worthy of noting regarding canister type oil filters. You'll notice in the accompanying picture that the filter is collapsing in on itself which in turn restricts oil flow. Occasionally I have seen these filters come apart when left in the engine too long.

So for the do it yourself oil service, we recommend that you carefully inspect your oil filter. If you see signs of the filter collapsing, it's been in way too long. Always use the proper long-life filter when you change your oil. Sure, some synthetic oils will go 10 – 15 thousand miles, but will your filter? Once again I am loving engineers for keeping us in business.

I recommend that even on cars that run the long life oils, that you still change it once a year or every 6,000 miles to prevent filter failure. Remember, an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure.

Though January can be a cold and blustery month, it gives us a great opportunity to sit by the fireplace and read all those issues of Panorama we didn't have time to read while the weather was warm. Drive carefully this winter, and we'll see you on the road when the ice melts

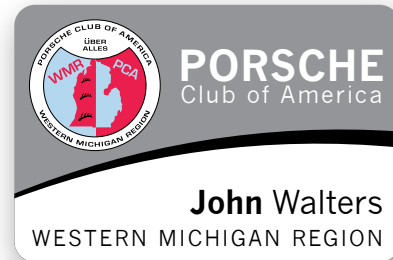

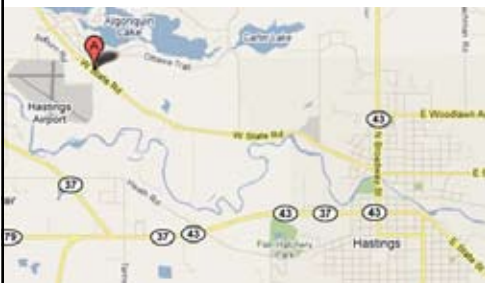
