As always, the food and service were excellent. And the key lime pie was apparently pretty good too (at least from the reactions at my end of the table).



WMR PCA's Continuing Support of MTSI

For the second consecutive year, the Western Michigan Region of the Porsche Club of America is supporting the Midwest Traffic Safety Institute, a non-profit organization founded in 2011 by Dave Muma and Century Driving School.

At the December WMR PCA board meeting, a check in the amount of \$1,660 was presented to Dave Muma of Midwest Michigan Traffic Safety Institute. Dave mentioned that our donations and company match last year assisted 34 individuals (primarily with road tests) through Arbor Circle.

Our current donations have been allocated for next year to assist high-risk kids in White Cloud. It will be a trial program assisting 12 students @ \$120/hour (the total cost would include an amount paid by the student along with our subsidy.) The program will start around Christmas break, with students receiving their driver licenses by late summer. There was discussion about having some of these students come to our Grattan DE event to help raise awareness of the value MTSI brings to West Michigan, and how our donations directly help these students.



TechSpalte: How to Change Your Oil

WITH OUR CARS STORED FOR THE WINTER, the shop slows down some from our normal hectic schedule. While we enjoy being busy, the winter slow-down gives us a chance to catch up on reading all those automotive/technical magazines we've set aside.

Recently during one quiet moment I ran across the following story. I laughed so hard I nearly fell out of my chair. So rather than writing another technical article this cold January night, I thought I share this mid-winter laugh with you instead. We'll get back to the technical topics next month, but in the mean-time, strap yourself in and laugh out loud.

How To Change Your Oil

Women:

- 1. Bring your car into the shop when the mileage reaches 3,000 since the last oil change.
- 2. Have a cup of coffee on us.
- 3. 20 minutes later, write a check and leave with a properly maintained vehicle.

Men:

- 1. Go to O'Reilly auto parts and write a check for 50 dollars for oil, filter, oil lift (AKA kitty litter), hand cleaner and scented tree.
- 2. Discover that your used oil container is full. Instead of taking it back to O'Reilly to recycle, dump in hole in back yard.

- 18. Next day, drag pan full of old oil out from underneath car
- 19. Throw oil lift (AKA kitty litter) on oil spilled during step 18.
- 20. Beer. No, drank it all yesterday.
- 21. Walk to 7-11; buy beer.
- 22. Install new oil filter making sure to apply thin coat of clean oil to gasket first.
- 23. Dump first quart of fresh oil into engine.
- 24. Remember drain plug from step 11.
- 25. Hurry to find drain plug in drain pan.
- 26. Hurry to replace drain plug before the whole quart of fresh oil drains onto floor.
- 27. Slip with wrench and bang knuckles on frame.
- 28. Bang head on floor board in reaction.
- 29. Begin cussing fit.
- 30. Throw wrench.
- 31. Cuss for additional 10 minutes because wrench hit your favorite Porsche souvenir.
- 32. Clean up; apply Band-Aid to knuckle.
- 33. Beer.
- 34. Beer.
- 35. Dump in additional 4 quarts of oil.
- 36. Beer.
- 37. Lower car from jack stands.
- 38. Accidentally crush one of the jack stands.
- 39. Move car back to apply more oil lift (AKA kitty litter) to fresh oil spilled during step 23.
- 40. Hang scented tree from mirror.
- 41. Drive car.


