
O8 Jun Pre-Parade Tech Session at Euro Autowerks





TechSpalte: Spring Into Summer With These Maintenance Reminders

CABIN AIR FILTER – Perhaps you just changed it last fall, but you had better check it. Often over the winter months, creatures eat right through them and get into the air



distribution box build their new home. One unfortunate resident had a pretty fast ride on the fan motor, resulting in some vibration when the fan was turned on.

OIL CHANGES – Oil fill tubes on our Boxters like to crack after time. If you change your own oil and see it dripping on

your floor after adding oil, this could be the cause. This hose runs from your oil fill cap down to the engine block and cracking is a common problem. If the tube breaks, it can also cause a vacuum leak, same as leaving your oil cap off. So if you see drips or your engine has a lot of oil on the pan side, this could be the cause.



EXTENDED OIL CHANGE PERIODS — Extending your oil service can have deadly results such as plugging up the oil pickup tube and screen. This is a problem that we are seeing in several manufacturer's cars that go with the "long-life" oil service. I'm sure you never let your Porsche oil service go to this extent, but many of us drive other cars that may.



Changing your oil is still the cheapest and best maintenance item you can do. Even though it may seem expensive, it's still a lot cheaper than paying to repair the damage caused by a plugged pickup screen.

Water Cooled Porsche Tip – If your temp gauge runs a little high or you're A/C doesn't perform like it used to, check the front air inlets for your radiators for debris. Often the radiators and condensers may be plugged up and proper air flow is prohibited. With a quick glance they may look clean, but often we find that they are plugged with fine debris between the units. Because they are sandwiched together, debris that gets between them often cannot get out.

CRITTERS AND CARS DON'T MIX – It doesn't take long for mice or other such animal to take up residence in your car. We recently removed a well built nest from a customer's 1986 911. It seems like the little guy found the space behind the front blower pretty cozy.

Another customer recently left his garage door up just long enough for a woodchuck to find a nice warm spot in the engine compartment of his Envoy. When the vehicle wouldn't start he opened the hood only to see a very upset woodchuck looking at him. After some exciting moments, the woodchuck was dispatched, but not until he had created more than eleven hundred dollars worth of damage.
