

tary. Aaron Ambrosino, the National Coordinator for the Tire Rack Street Survival Program, also spoke. Launched initially by the BMW Car Club of America in April 2002, Street Survival is a national driver education program for teens "aimed at teaching teens the skills they need to stay alive behind the wheel" and averting some of the over 6,000 deaths to teen drivers annually. There have been over 500 one-day driving schools since 2002 with the help of PCA, BMW, Audi, Mercedes, and other local car clubs, with the numbers growing rapidly as more groups come on board. There is already support among WMR members to join the ranks of groups hosting these worthy and important programs. I look forward to discussing this at upcoming Board meetings and social

events with anyone interested in participating. The real perk to the meeting was in meeting the presidents and attending officers of the other eleven Regions in Zone 4. Not surprisingly, they were a great group of people and along with their club members have organized a lot of great activities. The Central Indiana and Allegheny regions have some particularly interesting motorsport related activities coming up. **Spring Driving Tips.** After this past winter, I'm sure we are all looking forward to hitting the road for some enjoyable moments, but before you head out, here is a list of things you need to check to prevent an unenjoyable experience.

### Oil Service up to date

**Cooling system hoses and fluid levels** 

Clear any debris in front of the radiator or condenser

Inspect all belts

Check the suspension, brakes and tire wear

Make sure your A/C is up to the hot summer tasks

### Tire pressure and tread depth

Remember, for every 10 degree increase in temperature, your tire pressure will go up approximately 1 pound.

With your car checked out and any shortcomings corrected, there are some items to keep in mind so that your trip is safe for you and others on the road.

### Keep safety in mind when taking a trip:

- Do not overload you car's payload capacity.
- Secure your luggage and gear properly, as they can become projectiles if you have to make sudden stop or are involved in an accident.
- Use proper car seats for children and seat belts for all others. Make sure they are fitting and working properly. Anything less than 40 pounds can easily become a projectile, even kids.

- With the warming weather, we need to share the road with mopeds, motorcycles and bicycles. Remember when children are out of school, many are riding bikes with little or no awareness of those around them. Be alert to these extra road hazards
- Share your itinerary with family or friends, and take
  up to date paper maps with you as well as your
  favorite GPS system. It can be fun to follow your
  progress with maps and you may lose your GPS
  signal. Take the time to make sure your navigator can
  read a map and understands your route before you
  begin. There are a lot of people who have never used
  maps as a guide.
- Keep your fuel tank above ¼ of a tank. You never know when you will encounter a traffic jam or detour.
   It's no fun running out of gas. My rule has always been, if the car runs out of gas, the driver walks.
- Wet roads are a hazard, so slow down! The oil on the pavement can create a slippery condition much like ice. Try to avoid large puddles, as they may be hiding large pot holes.
- Slow down for construction zones and workers.
- Carry emergency items like flashlights, blankets, bottled water, non-perishable snacks and a first aid kit.
- Be alert for fatigue and take breaks. Do not drive if you are feeling drowsy. It's not good to wake up behind the wheel of a speeding or uncontrolled car. It's reported that approximately 100,000 crashes, 71,000 injuries and 1,500 deaths are related to fatigue or drivers going to sleep.
- Manage your stress level by preparing and planning ahead. Give yourself plenty of time to reach your destination.
