LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT



Mike Karluk President, Western Michigan Region

Work kept me from joining a number of our WMR members at the North American Auto Show in Detroit in January. I was able to stop by the Grand Rapids auto show and began with a quick walk through the "unobtainium" gallery of Aston Martins, Ferraris, and Rolls Royces. My ability to walk by these with an appreciative, but

cursory glance is probably less a factor of any spiritual evolution on my part than recognition that our Stuttgart stallions offer a far better combination of performance, dependability, and fiscal rationality.

The Lamborghini Huracán, however, did prompt me to stop and gaze longingly. The other car that captured my attention and was out of place in one sense, however, was a white 2015 Corvette Z06. With a base price of \$79,995, this car with it's 6.2-liter supercharged V8 putting out 650-bhp and 650-lb-ft of torque was actually quite obtainable. I quickly moved on through the show finding few cars of interest that I could fit into with my relatively long torso. I barely fit in a Camaro, I couldn't live comfortably with the new Lexus RC-F, and even the

VW Golf, which reminds me of my beloved 1990 Honda Civic Si, was too small. Thank God I have no problems fitting into all current Porsche models.

Our friends from Delta Porsche had a beautiful Boxster GTS on display that with its carbon ceramic brakes and other options weighed in a little north of \$100k. I was then informed that the Cayman GT-4 was being unveiled in Geneva this month and could be ordered. A quick check of the Porsche website revealed this object of my desire to have a base price of \$84,600 for its 3.8-liter flat six making 385 bhp and 309 lb-ft of torque. Porsche appears to be making a statement with the GT-4 by only having a 6-speed manual transmission. With what I considered necessary options, the GT-4 of my dreams priced out around \$92k, almost identical to the Corvette with the ZO7 option package.

These are interesting times to have a hankering for spirited driving when such different, but desirable machines are available for roughly the same price.

There is absolutely no question in my mind which of the two is prettier (even with that cop-magnet rear wing)!

I hope to see many of you at the Grattan Pub on March 18. Stay warm! — *Mike*





CABIN FILTERS - EASY DIY MAINTENANCE

Porsche began using cabin filters in 1995 on their 911 (933) cars, and with just basic technical knowledge and abilities you can replace them when needed.


CABIN FILTERS (POLLEN FILTERS) PLAY AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN A CAR'S HEATING AND AIR CON SYSTEM, TRAPPING POLLEN AND DEBRIS.

Though they may cost a little more, we always recommend you use a charcoal activated filter when possible, to help control smells and improve overall air quality.

Eventually, even under normal conditions, the filter becomes plugged. This decreases airflow into the system causing poor heating and cooling performance. Changing the filter in your car on a regular basis can help maintain a pleasant driving experience.

REPLACING FILTERS ON A 1995 - 1998 911 (993)


Open the hood and remove the plastic cowl cover by the windshield. There are two filters, one on each side of the blower housing.





- 1. Remove the thumb screws on the top of the filter cover.
- 2. Remove the wiring that runs across the top of the filters.
- **3.** Using a flat bladed screw driver, unclip the lower metal clips and slide the top cover upwards.
- 4. Lift the filters out.
- **5.** Take note of the position of the tab on the filter (it should be facing up for proper installation).
- **6.** Clean any debris out of the filter area.
- **7.** Install new filters, paying attention to the position of the tab for proper installation.
- **8.** Reinstall the wiring that was removed.

When reinstalling the filter cover, be sure you have it installed in the grooves so it slides down and seals correctly.

THE TAILPIPE

Survey Comment:

Non-Porsche owners are confused by the Über Alles name and think it has something to do with the Nazis of WW2 Germany.

This was one of many interesting comments from our December survey. Let's look to our club

history. In 1972 our newsletter was addressed to, or called "Porsche Pushers". In September of that year, we have the first issue, titled as Über Alles. Done with a typewriter and 3 pages long. I don't have any knowledge what prompted the change, but chances are, it was born out of admiration for our cars. Full stop. The end. — Interestingly, the Über Alles name did prompt me to pause, when I received my first Über Alles in the mail. I remember thinking to myself. No-one in Germany would name their newsletter like this. Why? — History.

Without historical context - the Über Alles expression, simply means "above all else", or arguably better than everything else. The phrase itself is borrowed from the "Deutschland Lied" (Song of Germany), the German national anthem composed by Joseph Haydn and written by A. H. Hoffmann von Fallersleben around 1841. Fun fact: Germany wasn't actually founded until 1871.

Fast-forward to 1932 and the start of Nazi rule. Three stanzas comprise the original song from 1841, of which the Nazis decided to use only the first stanza. Probably no need to elaborate why they thought the stanza with "Über Alles" in it, was just what Hitler ordered.

After the German people were liberated from the Nazis in 1945, it wasn't until 1952 that Germany decided to adopt only the third and last stanza as the official German national anthem. Holding true to the spirit of 1871 but staying well clear of any and all mentions of Über Alles.
