BE TURBOCHARGED

LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Putting together this month's letter was difficult, as initially I felt somewhat at a loss for words, which is a bit unusual. The primary cause for this was a statement published in the March 2015 issue of Britain's "GT Porsche" magazine in Andrew Frankel's interview of Wolfgang Hatz, Porsche's head of research and development, at

the North American International Auto Show. Frankel reported that the new Cayenne Turbo S, which was unveiled in Detroit with its bi-turbo V8 making 570 hp and 590 lb. ft., clocked an astonishing 7:59.74 minute lap of the Nürburgring Nordschleife, less than three seconds slower than the new 996 GT3 in the hands of Walter Röhrl in 1999! Also revealed were: 1) All future 911s will be turbocharged, except for the GT3 RS, 2) A Cayman GT4 and a high performance Boxster model were coming soon, and 3) Porsche was at work on a two seat, midengine production supercar akin to the Ferrari 458 and McLaren 650S. That means if you want to hear the song of a naturally-aspirated Porsche in a few years, you'll need to buy a 991, an older 911, or a Cayman/Boxster.

If you go to Porsche.com/USA, you can see and configure the new Cayman GT4 and Boxster Spyder, the latter which I think should command even more interest than its predecessor with it's awkward fabric top. In the May issue of "MotorSport" magazine, Frankel reported the GT4's time around the Nordschleife is halfway between that of the Cayman GTS and the 911 GT3 and that the Cayman GT4 "is as deserving a member of the Porsche Motorsport stable as any other." As to the new Porsche supercar, I'll probably read about it, but with those target competitors, its price point will put it beyond the point at which I stop even fantasizing. I'm seeing a lot of Porsches on the road and have recently run into a number of WMR members who have their Porsche out of winter storage. Barb and I enjoyed another wonderful evening at the Schiebles' Cookoff, sampling 14 different meatloaves. Marshall & John Walters are hosting a dinner drive to The Dock on Gull Lake on May 16; Herb Welz is giving a tour of his Euro Lighting Designs factor on May 22; and Jerry Arens & Amber Door are hosting the enormously fun sporting clays event at Blendon Pines Gun Club in on Saturday, May 23. Even more events are coming in June aside from Parade. Looking forward to seeing you soon! — Mike





RIGHTY TIGHTY, LEFTY LOOSEY. WHAT NOT TO DO WHEN SERVICING YOUR CAR.

DO NOT forget to check a service manual to make sure you are prepared to complete the job.

DO NOT begin a job without being sure you have the proper tools and ability to complete it. (Wrecker bills are expensive and bringing your car into a shop with boxes of loose parts and bolts can be expensive and ultimately cost more than having the shop do the work in the first place.)

DO NOT purchase "cheap" parts. They may not fit properly and are often unreliable.

DO NOT assume the part you need is in the box. Always check the box before leaving the store to ensure you have the proper part and everything that's supposed to come with it.

DO NOT put tools in your pocket, having them there is an open invitation to rips in your interior and scratches in your finish.

DO NOT wear rings or jewelry as these items can become caught in tight places or may cause an electrical burn if shorted out on a terminal or live wire. Damage may be done to your car as well.

DO NOT wear belt buckles made of metal or other material that will scratch your vehicle as you lean over it.

DO NOT forget to use a fender cover or if one is not available use your best bath towel.

DO NOT use your clothing as a "handi-wipe". Doing so will not only upset your wife, but may leave grease and oil stains or just plain old dirt on your interior. Hand towels work great! They are the ones your wife stores next to the bath towels, save yourself an extra trip and grab them both at the same time.

DO NOT use your car as a work bench or beverage holder as you can damage the finish very easily.

DO NOT place loose nuts, bolts or other parts in the engine bay area. If they are dropped they can be very difficult to find and/or retrieve and if forgotten they could cause damage to the engine or vehicle.

DO NOT forget to tighten fasteners as you go, forgetting to tighten them will result in a poor repair.

DO NOT overtighten fastener. Use the proper torque setting for each type fastener to avoid damage to the fastener or plastic parts.

DO NOT forget to lubricate or use anti-seize on fasteners.

DO NOT use anti-seize on spark plug threads. Doing so may cause a poor ground for the plug and result in a misfire.

DO NOT use an incorrect wrench size. This can round off the corners of fasteners making them useless.

DO NOT use improper bits on your fasteners. Using a Philips screwdriver when a Torx is required or other such scenarios can ruin your fasteners and tools.

DO NOT use any type of torch around rubber, cloth, brake lines, or, get ready for this, fuel lines. Remember also that there are fuel vapors in your intake system.

DO NOT forget where the fire extinguisher is when using a torch. This can be a tragic mistake if one is needed.

DO NOT use incorrect fluids or fasteners.

DO NOT continue working if you become frustrated or angry. Doing so may cause you to forget to tighten or install something or leave a tool in the engine bay. Rather take a break from the job and come back later.

DO NOT forget to have a large box of band aids on hand for the inevitable cuts and bruises.

DO NOT forget to remain calm and collected when you rap the xxxx out of your knuckles.

DO NOT forget to enjoy the experience.
