

LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Sunday, June 15, 2015 was a great day internationally as well as locally in the Porsche world. Porsche 919 hybrid race cars finished the 24 Heures du Mans in first, second, and fifth place; "Grey's Anatomy" star, Patrick Dempsey, and teammates Patrick Long and Marco Seefriend finished second in the GTE amateur division in their 911

RSR; and WMR members enjoyed a drive to an intimate concert by ragtime piano great, Bob Milne. Despite all three Audi R8 e-tron Quattros breaking the 40-year-old Circuit de la Sarthe lap record, the "underdog" #19 Porsche of LeMans rookie drivers Niko Hulkenberg and Earl Bamber and veteran Nick Tandy won the race a lap ahead of the second place #17 Porsche 919 and two and three laps ahead of the #7 and #8 Audis, respectively. This marks the seventeenth outright LeMans victory by Porsche and their first since leaving prototype racing after their 1998 victory. To achieve this in the second year of the 919's development against such competition is amazing. These exotic hybrids are playing a crucial role in the development of technology that will allow Porsche

and other manufacturers to continue making sports cars as CAFE mileage standards continue to rise and the racing is fantastic. Thanks to Rick Riley for organizing the Wednesday Night Cruise-in to the Gilmore Car Museum and Jim and Artis Schaaf for organizing the drive to the Bob Milne concert. Jim and Artis' Cayman demonstrated its versatility by proving to be an outstanding vehicle for a tailgating party! The concert was educational as well as delightful; ask any of the twenty WMR members in attendance the origin of the term "ragtime." Upcoming WMR PCA include the July 11 Deutsche Marques Event at the Gilmore Car Museum and the newly created July Appetizer Party at Barb and my West Olive home on Saturday, July 25. Same December Appetizer Party format without snow and the option to walk on the beach! I'll even be grilling brats and hotdogs! Monitor the wmr.pca.org website and look for e-mail blasts for further developments. Miscellaneous quote: "The [Cayman] GT4 is as far ahead of its competitor as any GT Porsche I can recall. Indeed it makes the question for those looking to spend such money of any proper sports car not why they should choose a Cayman GT4 but why on earth they might possibly not." - Andrew Frankel, GT Porsche, May 2015. 


BOXSTER CONVERTIBLE TOPS

Failures, inspection of water drains, overview of system components and conditions that must be met for the top to operate.

Items that commonly fail:

- · Micro switch at roof
- · Transmission lock
- Ball socket on push rods
- · Cables that drive the transmissions



Placing the top in the service position to inspect the water drains (left and right side, yellow arrows)

Open the top to only the point where the rear cover is completely open as shown in the above picture.


Unhook the cable ball sockets and cloth cover clips at rear. Pull rear bottom of the window upward.

Having completed these steps you can now access the rear drain area or with the removal of the covers, go into the engine bay. Drains are located on each side near the transmission and must be kept free of debris to prevent water damage in the car.

We recommend that they are cleaned annually.

Roof Components:

- 1. Relay Located at the fuse box, positions 14 & 15 (Picture 1)
- 2. Micro Switches –
 Located in roof and transmissions
- **3.** Micro Switches Misc. locations: parking brake, lock/unlock, B-Pillar and compartment lid (Pictures 2, 3, 4 and 5)
- **4.** Cables One to each motor and transmission (Picture A)
- **5.** Transmissions One on each side (Picture B)
- **6.** Motor Located in the engine compartment
- Push Rods Ball Sockets attach one on each side (Picture C)



Conditions that must be met for roof to operate:

- No speedometer signal over 5 km/h
- Electric motor plugged in.
- Terminal 15 is connected
- Fuse B6 (Row B Number 6) + Fuse D3 are Okay
- Parking brake is engaged

Next month we will cover diagnostic procedures and repair procedures.
