

 Keep a battery tender or trickle charger connected to your battery if it is going to be out of use for an extended period of time. It's better to charge it for a short time when it's down slightly than to have to totally recharge it from a deep discharge.



- Purchase a quality battery, trickle charger or battery tender.
- Remember, a battery that is disconnected will still slowly lose its charge. This is normal, so even disconnected batteries need to be kept in a good state of charge.
- Extreme temperatures (both hot and cold) are also very hard on batteries, so avoid storage areas such as snow banks or on top of your furnace.



COLD STORAGE

With so much more memory and power add-ons in today's vehicles, you may want to just use a battery tender. This will prevent the necessity of having to reset clocks, radios and T.P.S. systems to name a few. Also, most ECUs learn your driving habits and respond by resetting or adjusting the idle parameters and other systems of your vehicle. The loss of battery power can cause the loss of these learned memory settings.

FUN FACT: The necessity of a 12 volt battery came about due to the need for more power to start higher compression engines and to keep up with the electrical demands of additional accessories and options.

That completes our discussion of batteries and provides you with a complete picture of the importance of maintaining your vehicle's battery.

AUTOMOTIVE BATTERIES – PART THREE:

Recommended Battery Maintenance

The primary cause of battery failure is the breakdown of the plates (cells) and debris buildup inside the battery case. This breakdown is normal and occurs no matter what you do to stop it.

- Corrosion of the plates will hinder the cells ability to take a recharge as well as deliver the proper amount of power (voltage).
- Debris buildup can get so bad that it will short circuit a cell.
- The more times a wet cell (or any battery) is discharged and recharged, the faster it will breakdown/deteriorate.
- A deep or complete discharge speeds up deterioration, causing sulfating and corrosion breakdown of the cells.
- Automotive batteries that are in a very low state of charge need to be recharged slowly to prevent damage since they are not designed for a deep or complete discharge.
- Electrolyte levels must cover the cells of batteries that are not maintenance free.

Knowing the causes of battery failure, let's take a look at some ways to give your battery the very best care.

- Make sure your charging system is operating properly.
 Remember, both overcharging and undercharging can damage a battery.
- Keep the battery clean and dry. Dirt and moisture on top of a battery will cause a slow discharge.
- See that the terminals and wire clamps are clean and corrosion free.


