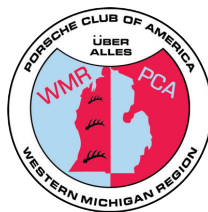

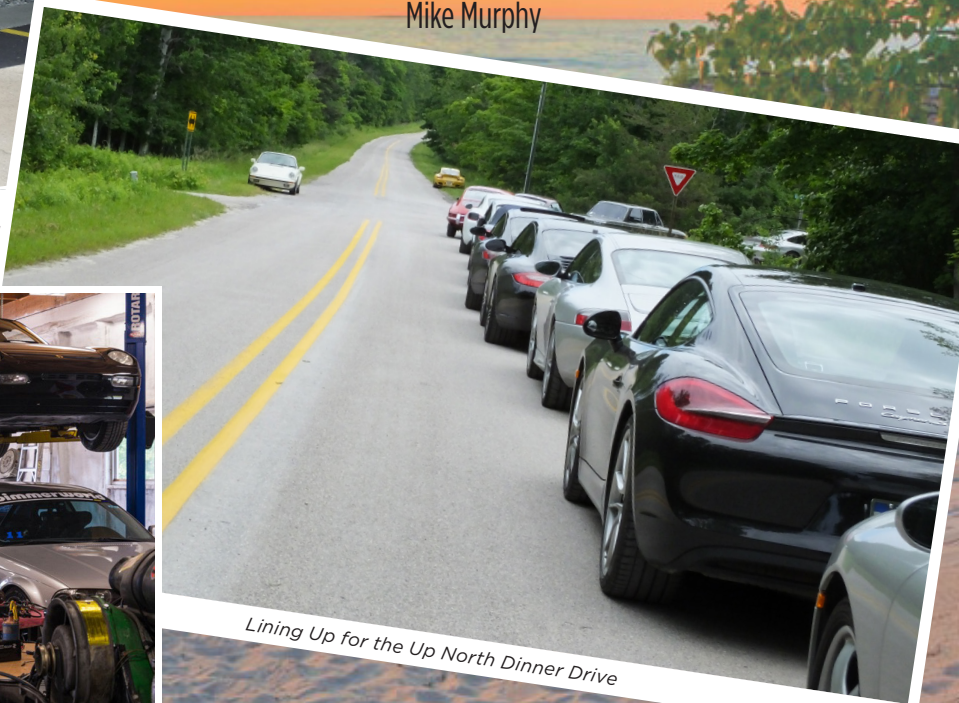

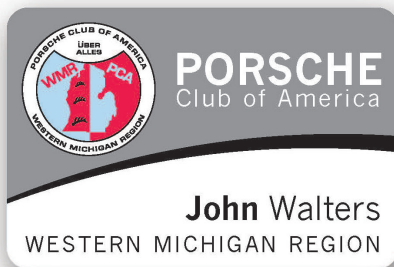

## POWER PROBES

A Continuation of our June 10<sup>th</sup> Tech Session...

Before I begin, I'd like to thank all of you who attended our Open House, so many great people and Porsches. The turnout exceeded our expectations as we had to get more brats for our world famous chef Red.

Special thanks to Red Masters for manning the grill and all those who helped make this event possible; from cleaning the shop, to hanging the banners and then cleaning up when it was over. We hope everyone enjoyed the day, we sincerely appreciated having you join us.

Now back to the tech session with a brief follow-up.

As many of you saw, a test light can be destructive in my hands and with the number of computers in our cars today, airbag systems and such can be damaged very easily. This is why we are trying to encourage you to replace the test light in your tool box, with a Power Probe.



I purchased the Power Probe 3 kit, pictured here from Snap-On for about \$250.00, but if you do some shopping around, you may be able to pick it up for a few dollars less. Once you have your kit, take a few minutes to watch the video on the CD that comes with it, to become familiar with its

operation. After watching the video, start using the probe in the simplest form. Simply hook the black/negative wire to the negative side of the battery and the red/positive wire to the positive side of the battery, and begin testing. First touch the power probe to the negative side and then to the power side just to get a feel for how it responds. The next step would be to try it on your fuses.

Remember, practice makes perfect and once you get used to the Power Probe, you will find it very useful for everything from testing a fuse or bulb, to checking a circuit. The more you use the probe, the more uses you'll find for it.
