RECALLS AND TECHNICAL SERVICE BULLETINS (TSB) UNDERSTANDING THEM BOTH AND WHAT THEY MEAN TO YOU

Safety recalls are a manufacturer's way of acknowledging its product has a flaw and if not corrected, this flaw could possibly jeopardize the safety of you and/or the passengers in your vehicle. When a recall is issued, the manufacturer notifies the vehicle owner and the manufacturer's service departments of the recall. There is no charge to the owner/customer for repairs performed due to the recall. A glaring example of this process is the recent Takata airbag recall which has affected 34 million vehicles.

If you are driving or thinking about purchasing a used car, it's wise to know how to find out if the vehicle has had any recalls that you may or may not be aware of. Porsche has its own website to help you with keeping track of recalls, just go to: https://recall.porsche.com/

prod/pag/vinrecalllookup.nsf/VIN?ReadForm and enter the required information and get a report for your vehicle.




There are numerous other sites that a consumer may use as well, such as National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), Edmunds and others.

With the rapid rise in the number of recalls, you may want to check your own vehicles. If one was issued on your vehicle, it may be wise to contact the dealer to see if it was ever performed.

While reviewing the graph below, you'll notice that other than 2004, recalls numbered less than 20 million per year through 2012. Beginning in 2013 recalls began to greatly increase until in 2014 we saw them grow to more than 50 million and more than 51 million in 2015.

Last year saw a record 51.26 million vehicle recalls, beating the previous mark set the year before.

So why the sudden rise in these numbers? Is it that manufactures are shortcutting their quality? Is it because cars have so many advanced features? Is it because manufacturers rush new models to the public before faults are worked out? Is it because the "watchdog" organizations are blowing the whistle making manufacturers more accountable to issues and accelerating their recall response time? Is it all the above? You be the judge.

Keep in mind that just because a vehicle has been or is being recalled, it is not a guarantee that the issue will occur, but that it affects a certain percentage of those vehicles. It is also not an indication that a particular vehicle is a bad one to own.

Next month we'll discuss Technical Service Bulletins and how they affect you and your vehicle. Until then enjoy our summer season and "drive it like you're renting it".


