DEEP THOUGHTS

LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT



Mike Karluk President, Western Michigan Region

I experienced some synchronicity recently regarding the issue of truth on a day when I read Andrew Frankel's review of the new Cayenne E-Hybrid in the May 2018 "GT Porsche" and heard an interview with Jimmy Carter speaking about his new and 32nd book, "Faith; A Journey for All." Writing on what might be the demise of diesel vehicles in Europe, Frankel stated: "Rightly or wrongly (entirely wrongly in my not completely uninformed opinion), diesel is dying because its manifest benefits have been swamped by a perfect storm of political grandstanding and stupidity coupled with willfully venal reporting in the mainstream media from those more concerned with viewing figures or circulation than the increasingly underrated concept known as the truth." Speaking of much broader issues, Carter stated: "We've

lost faith in freedom, we've lost faith in the value of telling the truth. We've lost faith in personal integrity. We've lost faith in some of the very principals that have made us a successful democracy." I'll confine myself here to matters automotive.

In the wake of the VW group's "Dieselgate" scandal, Frankel reported that Dusseldorf and Stuttgart have banned older diesels from their city centers and expressed concern that Dieselgate has damaged consumer confidence in diesel vehicles to an extent that demand for them will evaporate or companies will refrain from manufacturing them. He stated: "Modern diesels are clean, they are far less wasteful of fossil fuels, cheaper by far for high mileage users, offer excellent range, terrific power deliver and, let's not forget 20 percent less CO2 than petrol engines. And we're all about to turn our backs on them." Commenting on the Cayenne E-Hybrid's "many talents," Frankel reported that the electric motors and batteries pushed the weight of the Panamera E-Hybrid 320 kg over the weight of the non-hybrid Panamera and reasoned a similar gain in weight for the E-Hybrid Cayenne over the Cayenne with a gas or diesel engine will reduce its fuel efficiency during highway cruising when the hybrid is not most efficient as well as adversely effecting its handling.

I probably missed it, but the reporting on "Dieselgate" I read was focused on VW management's admitted emissions software chicanery rather than objective data regarding the difference between actual emissions and the test emissions of vehicles with the rigged software and how it compared to emissions from gasoline-powered variants of the same vehicles. I haven't had time to explore this issue, but would love to hear about it when we meet again at the Chili Cook-off on April 21 or the Sporting Clays on May 19th.





TURBOS: THEN AND NOW

Turbo = Exhaust driven turbine designed to induce pressure into the intake and combustion chamber, resulting in more compression which produces more power.

One of the main advantages of a turbo over a supercharger is that the turbo uses a waste product, the exhaust, whereas a super charger is run off a belt, driven by

the crankshaft. Both are designed to induce pressure into the intake; however the supercharger uses power from the engine to produce power, while the turbo uses the exhaust gases (a waste product) to produce its power.

Turbocharging was around as early as 1885, about the same time as the internal combustion engine was developing. It was in 1925 that an engineer by the name of Alfred Buchi was reportedly the first to be successful using it on an internal combustion engine. It is reported that he achieved a 40% increase in power.

Jumping ahead many years, the Corvair Monza was turbocharged in 1962 in response to Ford's introduction of a 260 V8 in the Falcon. This early turbo on the Monza had nothing controlling it! However fast it spun and whatever pressure resulted, is what the engine received.

This turbo did not produce a tremendous amount of boost due to its design, but it did help create more power if you could get it started while hot. Now let's jump ahead to the Porsche turbocharged cars.

I am sure that you have all heard of the 1,100 hp 917 race cars, or how about the 911 Carrra RSR 2.1 turbo that was run in the 1974 season. Then there is the 935 with a 750 hp, 226 mph speed monster. These fire breathing beasts were marvelous, the noise, the fireball roaring out of the exhaust on deceleration. What fun to see these cars in

how Porsche

went from those fire breathing turbocharged race cars to a 924 turbo (kinda felt like a Corvair) but thank goodness they gave us the 911 turbo and next generation 930 3.0 and 3.3 liter. Today Porsche engineers continue to provide us with great turbo cars.

In the 70s and 80s, availability of turbocharged cars was very limited, but today turbocharging has become the mainstay among many manufacturers.

Next month we'll look at early Porsche turbo designs and compare them to the turbos of today.


