

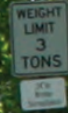

There is a plethora of Porsche-related activities in August. Our friends at the German Auto Service in downtown Grand Rapids are hosting their annual open house on Saturday, August 11 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., while Chris and Craig Ackerman's annual pool party/bacchanalia begins at 4 p.m. that evening. The St. Ignace Chamber of Commerce is hosting a Porsche extravaganza from Friday, August 17 through Sunday the 19th for those interested. The Grand Rapids Metro Cruise will begin on Friday evening, August 24 and we anticipate another great gathering hosted by our friends at Porsche Grand Rapids. On Saturday, August 25, the Michiana region will be hosting IROC III at the Tire Rack facility in South Bend, IN from 9 a.m. until 4 p.m. and closer to home, Wolfgang Hoffman is sponsoring a dinner at the lovely Alpenrose Restaurant in beautiful downtown Holland, MI at 5 p.m. for those who would like to finish an afternoon of shopping with a great meal with friends. For those with more high-octane interests, registration is now open for the WMR annual DE track weekend, the Grattan Grand Prix, on Saturday and Sunday, September 8 and 9. For those not interested in wantonly increasing their carbon footprint, parade laps will run on the Grattan course from noon until 1 p.m. on both Saturday and Sunday, with the \$20 donation going to support Family Promise of Grand Rapid. Please consult our fantastic and authoritative website at wmi.pca.org for further details and thank Craig Paull whenever you see him for all his hard work on this site.

Since writing last month, Porsche's 919 Evo prototype piloted by works driver Timo Bernhard shattered Stefan Bellof's thirty-four-year-old lap record of the Nürburgring Nordshleife of 6:11.13 by an astounding 51.58 seconds with a time of 5:19.55. The Evo hit a top speed of 230 mph on the finishing straight despite the aero package maximized for downforce. Check out the in-car footage on You Tube. Borrowing from aerodynamic data gleaned from the 919 prototype, Volkswagen fashioned the 671 bhp all-electric, four-wheel drive I.D. R which piloted by two-time LeMans and four-time Pike's Peak International Hill Climb champion, Romain Dumas, set an all-time record on Pike's Peak on June 24 with a time of 7:57.148. This was 15 seconds faster than the previous record set in 2013 by Sebastian Loeb, which obliterated the previous record by 92 seconds. Maybe the all-electric 600-hp Porsche Taycan, the production version of the Mission E (which was also on display at Parade) due out in a year or so, will blow a lot of people away as well as provoke even more debate than PDK vs. manual.

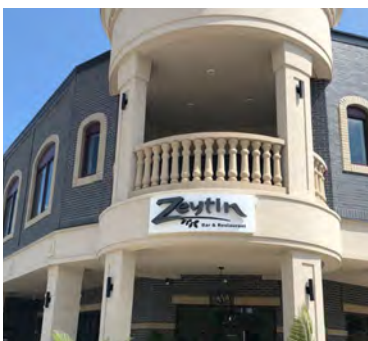

UNDERSTANDING TURBOCHARGERS PART TWO

Variable Geometry Turbochargers The Pinnacle of Turbocharging!

Cost for one Variable Geometry Turbocharger (VTG) 997.1 turbo is 3,300 £ (\$6,000-\$7,000) per turbo, and you need two.

VGT turbos have been around for some time, but mainly used on heavy duty diesel applications.

Porsche first introduced us to them in 2007 on the 997 Turbo and is one of the few manufacturers that still use them on their cars today. Most manufacturers have gone away from the VGT to twin scroll turbos. VGT turbos are expensive to manufacture because of the highly specialized materials used to cope with the high EGT (Exhaust Gas Temperature) and the extra components.

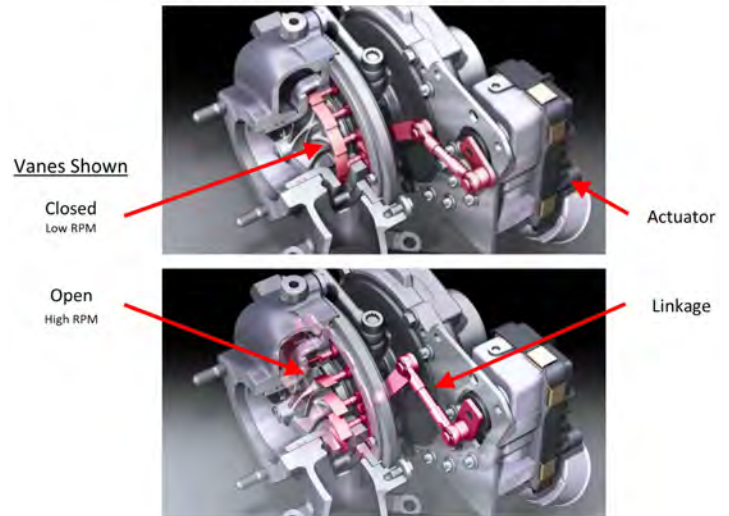
The biggest attraction for using a VGT is the almost constant boost (no turbo lag) as it delivers the most appropriate amount of boost at all RPMs. It replaces the need for two turbos, one small (low RPM) and one large (high RPM) as the control vanes in it act as a small turbo when closed (flat) allowing fast spool up. As the RPMs increase the vanes open up and it becomes/acts like a large turbo, supplying more boost at the higher RPMs.

The control vanes are electronically controlled by the engine's ECU and changes are made in the in the angle of the vanes in as little as 1/100th of a millisecond. This allows for a longer, flatter distribution of torque (torque = acceleration) and eliminates the need for a waste gate.

The 997.1 still uses many controlling factors for boost, just as explained last month, such as inner coolers, recirculation valves, sensors, etc.

Though this is a brief explanation of the 997.1, it gives you a pretty good idea of the benefits of the unit.

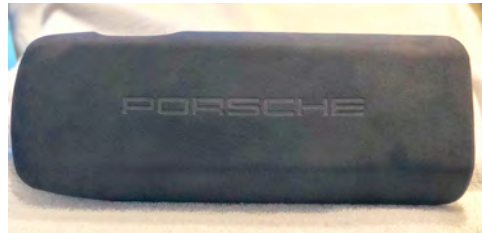
