

## IN REVIEW: 70 YEARS OF PORSCHE CARS, VINEYARD TOUR AND FALL COLOR DRIVE

#### SESSION 1: A CELEBRATION OF 70 YEARS OF THE PORSCHE AUTOMOBILE

On October 20, it was still dark at 7:30 am in Traverse City, Hagerty Insurance generously made available two of their however 42 headlights and 21 Porsches (good when the numbers work out that way) piloted by enthusiasts from Traverse City, Suttons Bay, Northport, Cedar, Petoskey and Rockford staged under the massive and "official" Porsche 70 year banner in the parking lot of MFD Classic Motors. All were deftly marshalled into their warm and bright interior display area within the MFD building.

Over the next 210 minutes, 300 automobile and Porsche enthusiasts ogled, googled and canoodled the displayed cars and interacted with the Porsche owners and each other. 


## WINDOW REGULATORS OFTEN FORGOTTEN, NEGLECTED AND UNAPPRECIATED... UNTIL THEY FAIL

Early window regulators rarely failed due to their robust and simplistic design. About the only thing that would



happen to them is the knob would fall off the window crank. These regulators were most commonly a scissors style design made of real STEEL. They had two functions, window up and window down.


Today's window regulators have many functions and are normally a cable driven style, Bowden system, double Bowden system or a scissor style still driven by way of a cable. The new systems are made with plastic control wheels, cables inside of plastic housings and are driven by multi-functioning motors.

Some of the functions or duties of today's regulator are:

- Window drop at door open
- Window raise at door close
- · Open or Close with key fob
- · Open or Close with key in door
- Open or Close position with switch
- Automatic up or down function
- · Comfort one touch operation with switch
- Courtesy operation with key off until you open the door or it times out
- Auto stop in case you put something in it (like your kids hands) that slows down the motor (in most cases, today's cars will reverse the motor preventing damage or injury)

These functions are controlled by micro switches, chips, processors and control units.

Some symptoms of regulator failure are:

- · Abnormal noise
- Slow operation
- · Does not fully close
- · Does down while you are putting it up
- No longer does the down/up function properly with the door open or closed
- Window goes up and down crooked
- · Finally, window drops into the door and stays there

Regulator failure can be caused by:

- Widow felts or rubber seals sticking due to heat which in turn causes the motor to work harder
- Ice on the window freezing it in place or hanging onto the window while operation it

All of these cause the cables and plastic wheels to be stressed and fail prematurely.

You can head off early failure by giving your regulator some love. Pay attention to its operation, do not operate it if the window is frozen or binding and if you see symptoms of early failure, get it checked out and repaired before it completely fails.

As with the other systems in your car, good maintenance, proper use and early repair when necessary can save you time and money.

Time for winter storage is upon us and it's important that we properly store our rides. To help you properly prepare your car, we have placed previous Tech Spalte articles on our Facebook page. Please take a few minutes to review the suggestions we have made.

I'd like to wish each of you a great Thanksgiving and encourage each of us to take a moment to consider all that we have.
