REFLECTIONS

LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

The West Michigan Region of PCA has lost a great friend with the death of Kurt Wirth on Thursday, November 29, who succumbed to cancer. Kurt joined the WMR in 1979 and served as President, organized the Grattan track weekend for fourteen years, kept our region's archives as Historian for longer than anybody could say, and was our Insurance coordinator. He was a charming and debonair character who was interested in getting to know everyone and always wanted to know how you were doing. I had no idea Kurt was ill until I receive an email from him on October 29 simply requesting that I relieve him of his duties because of his increasing health problems. I was informed of the gravity of his health problems the week before Thanksgiving and created a Certificate of Appreciation for all his contributions to the club. Kurt passed before we could present it to him, but it was received with heartfelt gratitude along with a card of condolence signed by the forty-six attendees of the Holiday

Appetizer Party by the younger of his two sons, Alex, during our December Board. Alex told us that Porsche cars were chronologically the first of Kurt's three great loves of his life, the second being his family, and the third his career with S.C. Johnson corporation.

I was working on a personal letter to Kurt thanking him for all his contributions to the club when I learned of his passing. While considering this task, I thought about a question that occasionally comes up during reflective moments: What was the happiest time in your life? My reflexive response, that I'll stick to with some qualifiers, was the ten-year period between graduating from college and entering medical school when I was actively involved with the University of Chicago Track Club as a competitor, assistant coach, official, and ultimately as Coach following the death of its founder and my mentor, Ted Haydon. I had interesting hospital and counseling jobs during the work day that ultimately led me into medical school and my career as a psychiatrist while training, competing, and officiating on nearly a daily basis year-round after work and on weekends as a member of a large and vibrant community of individuals bonded by their love of track and field. My experience with the WMR of PCA parallels my experience with the Track Club. The camaraderie Barb and I have experienced with a wonderfully diverse group of people who share a common passion for Porsches in our nine years of membership in the WMR has been similar and I can't help but think Kurt must have had the same experience, albeit for thirty-nine years. Thanks for being one of the many standout individuals who has enriched my life for the past nine years, Kurt, and thanks to his wife, Shirley, for sharing him with us.

January will bring a changing of the guard on the Board. Jim Chiavaras will be stepping up as newly elected President, Frank Connor is replacing Jim as Vice President, and Marshall Walters is taking over the job of Secretary so ably executed for years by Brenda Hildon-Kaempf. Chuck Olenyk is assuming the Historian post and Tyan Roelands is taking over coordinating Insurance for group driving events. It's been an honor and privilege to serve as President for the past five years. Thank you all and have a wonderful and safe holiday season.

Kurt Wirth 1930 - 2018

A long-time member of Western Michigan Region left us Thursday, November 29. Kurt was born and raised in Germany and had some interesting tales of life there. Eventually he migrated to the US and became a citizen. He was employed much of his life by S. C. Johnson, working for the company both in Europe and here. He acquired his beloved 1965 356 SC in Europe and brought it to America with him. In 1979, Kurt joined Porsche Club and WMR. During his time with the club he served in a variety of posts, including President, the Grattan driving event chair, and most recently historian and insurance coordinator. Kurt is survived by his wife Shirley, a sister (Monica Kreitz, who lives in Germany), two adopted sons (Geoffrey Towner Wirth and Alexander Reed Wirth-Cauchon) and his daughter Stephanie Alexandra Wirth along with their family members. Kurt had four grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. He was a regular at a variety of events, and always brought with him a touch of European flair. 





ALL IN A DAY'S WORK AT EURO AUTOWERKS

While most of our customers are pretty good at having their cars serviced in a timely manner, every now and then a vehicle comes in which has not been properly serviced. The following pictures show examples of what can happen when regular service is overlooked.

Oil is the lifeblood of your engine, not changing it in a timely manner can cause major damage and wear. Proper service will avoid filter failure such as these.



Life-time coolants and lubricants are only good for the salesman, not your car. Contaminates and heat can combine to turn your "life-time" material into poison for your car. Check out these cups of "life-time" coolants. Which would you want in your car?



High engine temperatures can wear on an engine's components. Here is why we recommend checking and cleaning your radiator on a regular basis to keep the air flowing and prevent corrosion of the corners.





Fuel systems can become plugged and inoperative when fuels set too long in a vehicle. Over time, gasoline that sits in the tank will turn into varnish. When moisture gets into the gas, it causes rust inside the tank which will eventually end up in your carburetors.

These pipes came un-glued and came apart. These pipes have been "pinned" and will remain connected.





Here's a great picture of what you don't want me to find inside of your car's transmission. Transmission gear failure equals a bad day.




