
Has it stopped raining yet? I hope so, if it hasn't, I Noah a guy! I liked that joke!



### PORSCHE E.P.S (ELECTRIC POWER STEERING)


WHY THE PORSCHE SYSTEM STILL GIVES THE DRIVER FEEDBACK INFORMATION

Some advantages the electric system has over the hydraulic system that it replaced:

- No more need for a pump and hoses
- No more messy leaks from lines, pump or steering racks
- · No engine drag from running a pump
- The ability to have power assist with start or stop technology

As with most automotive systems, EPS systems continue to evolve with changes made to improve handling and feel.

The conventional E.P.S used on many cars leave a lot to be desired when it comes to feeling the road, making one feel




like a passenger rather than driver. They are fixed rate or "graph" units, and the assist does not change with road force or adapt to driving conditions. While this makes for a smoother

driving car, it gives very little feedback.



Conventional systems are considered "top down" systems, whereby the motor and control are along the steering shaft and operate on a fixed graph.



Electric Rack and Pinion Steering. Note motor and control unit mounted above the Rack and Pinion. Top down control with motor.

Porsche E.P.S. is considered a "bottom up" system since the motor is on the steering rack itself. This allows Porsche to leave the amount of assistance


open and controlled by the Porsche rack force controller.



Electric Rack and Pinion Steering. Note motor is mounted parallel to the Pinion for "Bottom Up" control of motor.

Porsche's E.P.S system uses information including the steering angle, turn rate and loads of other information provided by the Stability Control System Sensors, to vary the

#### amount of assistance.



The Porsche E.P.S. system transfers rotational motion to axial motion through the use of ball bearings. Such a system produces less friction, which allows more true information to be transferred to your hands.
