



COMMON QUESTIONS


Cam Deviation

I'm often asked about cam deviation and does it indicate a bad IMS bearing, so I'm going to offer the following information and comment.

Taken from the factory manual:

"The factory cam deviation spec is 0 degree +/- 6 degrees."

Referring to the picture provided below, you will note that the cam being checked is off slightly. A deviation as slight as this is most likely caused by chain guard pads. Deviation with a failed IMS would be much a greater number and you would find particles of a failed bearing in your oil filter.



Cam Deviation

There are also other factors that can affect deviation such as a failed cam adjuster, adjuster solenoids or cam sensor. So the key to remember is "Never Assume".

Durametric Rev Ranges

Another question that I'm often asked is "what are the rev ranges per Durametric's six ranges, so here's a handy chart showing the rpms per range.

- Range 1: 7200 7500 (7300 7500 for 911)
- Range 2: 7500 7700
- Range 3: 7700 7900
- Range 4: 7900 8400
- Range 5: 8400 9500
- Range 6: 9500 and up (This occurs when the engine is overrevved when downshifting into a lower gear.
 This is certainly bad for the engine and should be avoided.)
