





We Love the Mouse



Not knowing how much longer Old Man Winter will allow us to drive our cars, I thought it might be wise to review the process of properly storing your car. Implementing these suggestions can save you a lot of money and keep your car running and looking good.

- Changing the oil and filter will eliminate the contaminates that accumulated during the summer and prevent possible damage they may cause. Having fresh oil in your engine is one of the best things you can do to prevent problems down the road.
- Fill your gas tank, adding stabilizer per the instructions. Once you have the tank topped off, run the car for about twenty minutes to allow the stabilizer to get into all the fuel lines and injectors.
- Starting the engine while in storage is not recommended. Short run times build up moisture in the engine and exhaust system and can be harmful over time.
- Use a Battery Tender!
- Adding 10 pounds or so of extra air to your tires
 can eliminate flat spots and keep your tires rolling
 smoothly. It also helps to move the car a foot or so
 from time to time, to let it rest on a different spot or
 use tire dollies.

Rodents! This is one topic that we cannot mention too many times. Every spring we end up repairing the damage rodents have made during the winter. Cabin and air filters make great nesting materials, so make sure to prepare your engine compartment and surrounding area well. Keep in mind that mice can get though the smallest hole, notice the picture of the mouse working its way through the ½" holes in a piece of wire mesh.

Your car's wiring is a prime target for rodents. Some people believe they eat wiring to sharpen their teeth or to make nesting material. Perhaps a more practical reason wiring is a target, is that in an effort to "go green", wiring manufacturers began making the insulation for their wiring out of soy (as in soy beans). Consequently, the insulation became a potential meal.

So how do we stop rodents from snacking on our cars? Here are just a few suggestions:

- Dryer Sheets Place plenty of dryer sheets in and around your car, making sure you place them under the hood, in all door pockets, tail pipes and any place mice may travel. Replacing the sheets each month during the winter improves your odds of keeping rodents away. One caution: remember where you place them and make sure you remove all of them in the spring.
- Electrical devices There are some electrical devices such as "Pest Destruct" which emit ultrasonic waves that rodents dislike. I personally have not tried these items but I have a noise generator for barking dogs which works very well. It's activated by a barking dog, but once activated, they become very quiet and hide. My dog Mokey hates it, so does our neighbor's dog.
- Cedar balls Cedar balls seem to work okay when spread in and around your car. Moth balls work very well but in either case your car will absorb some of the smell they create. I place tin cans containing moth balls, around the inside edges of my garage to deter any pesky critters.
- Mouse (Snap) Traps Setting mouse traps by the front and rear edges of your tires will help keep mice out of your car. Mice use the tires to climb up and into your
- Peppermint Spray Rodents pee on everything and mark their path to and from their destination with it.
 Using a peppermint or similar spray around your tires, under the hood and in similar areas, can help cover their path and possibly prevent their travels. Such sprays should be reapplied periodically.

Unfortunately, Porsches are not immune to rodent damage, so take care of your stored car by planning and implementing a good defensive plan. Keep in mind that rodents are no respecter of who you are or what you drive. If it's parked, it's a target.

Lastly, don't forget your winter ride. Have its coolant, brakes, tires, heating system and state of tune checked. We offer a great discounted labor rate to our Porsche Club customers for whatever you own, and will be happy to go over it for you.
