

# Inish Toast & Blessing May the friendships you make be those which endure and all of your grey clouds be small ones for sure.



#### 120 YEARS AGO - 1900



Working for the Jakob Lohner & Company, 25 year old Ferdinand Porsche introduced the "The Lohner-Porsche Mixte Hybrid" in 1900. Instead of a massive battery-pack, an internal combustion engine built by the German firm Daimler drove a generator which in turn drove the electric wheel hub motors. As a backup a small battery pack was fitted. This is the first petroleum-electric hybrid vehicle on record. Notice the wheel hub design.

#### 50 YEARS AGO - 1970

The class of the field at the 1970 Rolex 24 At Daytona was the Porsche 917 driven by Pedro Rodriguez of Mexico, Leo Kinnunen of Finland and Englishman Brian Redman. The No. 2 John Wyer Gulf Porsche 917 dominated winning by 45 laps over its sister car, the No. 1 Gulf Porsche 917. Rodriguez, who scored his third of four Rolex 24 victories in 1970, won his first at the 24-hour distance. He was behind the wheel when the No. 2 Gulf Porsche 917 took the lead two hours and 35 minutes into the race and never looked back.

Redman holds the unusual distinction of driving on both the first and second place cars. Redman and Jo Siffert teamed up to drive the No. 1 Gulf Porsche 917. But the No. 2 Gulf Porsche crew was having difficulty communicating with Kinnunen and Redman filled in for a shift.

Later that year at the BOAC 1000 km at Brands Hatch, Pedro's magnificent ability in the rain to a 5 lap victory prompted fellow driver, Chris Amon, a pretty good racer in the wet himself to say "Can someone tell Pedro that it's raining?".



#### SO YEARS AGO - 1970



The Porsche 914 and 914-6 offered an optional wheel by Mahle that just may have been inspired by those of the "Mixte Hybrid". Ironically, the Mahles now have the nickname "gas burners". In the picture, both from the class of 1970 is our first Porsche and our Social Events Coordinator, Lynne Olenyk, up on the Belknap Lookout, in Grand Rapids.
