No, this months column is not about micro beers, but rather how our Region was originally brewed. And we can undoubtedly refer to Philip Gidley and William Sholar as the "Founders".

During the later months of 1960, Bill Sholar held the position of the first PCA Executive Secretary. But it was years before at his Alexandria, Virginia apartment where a "gripe-group" of early Porsche owners would meet. It eventually lead, in August 1954, to the formal organization of the Porsche Club of America with Bill as its first president. At one point during those early years, Bill was simultaneously president, Panorama editor, production manager, chief administrative officer, Parade chairman, and Potomac Region president. Net search "An Homage to Bill Sholar" for a wonderful story by former Pano editor Betty Jo Turner about Bill.

East Lansing's Philip Gidley was our regions counterpart. The closest organized Porsche Club region at that time was in Detroit. Phil took it upon himself to contact the interested Porsche owners and coordinate a formal application to form a new region, the Western Michigan Region. He was also going to grad school, living in an apartment, a 356 was his daily driver, and he welcomed the birth of his first daughter that same year. I've reached out to Phil's daughters and they have agreed to help with a future UberAlles article about him including an genuine disagreement with the hospital staff about the vehicle he intended to bring his new baby girl home in, a 4-cam Carrera Speedster!

In this day of Internet communication, instant messaging, zooming, and unlimited free long distance, traditional business letter writing has pretty much become a lost art. Few people take the time to write using anything close to the Queen's English. In our history files, we have fortunately saved the elegant correspondence over the course of four months in 1960 between Gidley and Sholar that gives us a look at the beginnings of our Region sixty years ago this month. What follows are a few excerpts from those letters.

August 18,1960 - Phil Gidley wrote to fellow western Michigan Porsche owners.

With best wishes, Philip A. Gidley"

October 8, 1960 - Gidley to Bill Sholar requesting what organizational materials are needed.

"I have just finished twenty personal letters, so please be a bit forgiving to any shortcomings of this note.....I have received enthusiastic replies from as far north of Grand Rapids as Traverse City, with 70% taking time to reply personally.

...I suppose the group is a bit unique, at least as it stands now, for 50% preface their names with Dr. ...I have heard so much about you from Earl(then PCA President, Earl Kirschbaum) that I feel we should be old acquaintances. Possibly the '61 Parade will at least give us the opportunity to shake hands, and match faces with letters.

With best wishes, Philip A. Gidley"

October 16, 1960 - Sholar to Gidley noting the "special importance" to carefully list the Regional Boundaries with "WRITTEN PERMISSION" from adjacent Regions to take over what was previously their area.

"It is good to see a group taking shape in Western Michigan...I know that it has been difficult for PCAers to take part in activities in Detroit.....Enclosed is some material which, if you will dig thru it, should provide most of the information you'll need to help organize. I am sending separately a large PCA Banner which will lend a bit of authenticity to your meeting....a little token to the new Region.

Cordially, Bill Sholar"

October 31, 1960 - Gidley to Sholar after the first organized meeting held October 22nd at the Greenridge Country Club in Grand Rapids.

"Let me first thank you for the help and cooperation you have given me in my attempt to rally a few hearty Porsche owners together to form a new PCA region. Thirty-one enthusiastic individuals attended the planning meeting, and so we are on our way!We are operating with a board of directors until December elections take over, and seemed to reach a general consensus on what we want our region to be. We have a hard core that want to take the bull by the horns, so with a little direction, I feel we are in good shape. "With best wishes, Phil"



November 12, 1960 - Petition for recognition as a "Charter Region" sent to Dr. Earl Kirschbaum, PCA President, signed by the first WMR officers Philip Gidley, Norman Dunn, John Owen plus the seven additional original members.

"The undersigned....herewith petition for the recognition as a "Chartered Region" of the Porsche Club of America....The name of the Region will be PCA, Western Michigan Region..... If Charter is granted, (WMR/PCA) will observe the requirements and Objectives set forth in the By-Laws of the Porsche Club of America and will conduct itself in such a manner as to be a credit to PCA and the Marque"

The Charter was granted on November 26, 1960
