

A LOOK BACK..."NO-DRIFT" FARM RACEWAY

Using Google Maps "Satellite" view, go to 68697 Territorial Rd., Benton Harbor, MI. You can still see what looks like a backyard walking trail loop. But once upon a time this was a venue for Solo and Autocross events used by many clubs including Porsche Club back in the 1970's. It was called the Nothdruft Hills Sports Farm.

Michigan-Indiana region member, Dan Williams, wrote in the June 1978 issue of Über Alles; "The first time that I came into contact with Nothdruft Hills Sports Farm was at the Holiday On Wheels event hosted by



Western Michigan Region in 1976. As I drove over the hill at the gate, what I saw was a winding, snaky, 10 foot wide ribbon of pavement which left me with a first impression of not looking forward to competing. The first session at Nothdurft Farms gave me the sensation of riding on a roller coaster, but on this ride, the car can leave the track!"



Thanks to Merle Durren, president of Peoples Savings Association of Benton Harbor, and his son Bob, the area sports car enthusiasts were able to compete on a beautiful 3/4 mile rolling road course near Watervliet, Michigan. Back in the "50's", Merle gathered track designs from many road courses that were in use throughout the country and then combined all of the various driving situations into the configuration of the course he built on his Michigan farm. Merle did not want to get involved with the tasks of managing a course for wheel-to-wheel competition, but he did feel that a one lane wide road course would more than serve his purpose. That was a practice course for his son and his Alfa Romeo. Merle felt

that in traffic situations which develop during a race, the driver must be able to judge a line and drift only within his width. This one-lane philosophy did work, for Bob proceeded to be one of the leading national competitors for approximately 6 years in his Alfa. Nothdruft became the most widely used Solo course in the area with events at least once a month from April through September.



In an email, former Über Alles editor Shari Hoek and husband Doug remembered that the original contact about using Nothdurft was through WMR member Phil Cull who knew the Durrens from the time he was in law enforcement in the Benton Harbor area. "We knew Merle's son Bob who was a friend of Phil's. Legend has it that the track was built by father, Merle, as a personal playground, some say, doing "hot laps in a Cadillac!". Bob would come out (with WMR) from time to time in his Cosworth Vega, Black with Gold. Pretty cool for being a Vega. The timing tower was a WMR member Charlie Richardson design and was sized, cut and drilled by Charlie at his home. Owner Bob supplied the materials. Upon arrival at the track, it went together like a large Lego set and was up and running in just a few hours. Many accolades and thank-yous to Charlie during the christening BBQ which took place after construction. Those who knew the track, narrow as it was, actually had a line to drive through the turns. Just, guessing, the track was only about 10 feet wide. Fun reminiscing about No-Drift Farm!!"







Chuck "Charlie" Richardson added "As I recall an "insurance" issue that kept us from using Nothdurft Farms again was that the young Vega owner the track was built as a playground for, and who graciously let us run there for a few years, was promoted to an officer in his father's bank, and hence the bank could be a party to any legal action that

resulted from an accident, or injury at the track. I thought that the bank actually insisted on putting bollards across the track to prevent anyone from sneaking onto it even. That could be a figment of my imagination however. Sadly I don't think the timing stand was used for more than a year at the most but it was a fun project at the time!"

One of the largest events WMR held at Nothdruft was the IROC autocross on June 24, 1978 when forty-two drivers from four PCA regions competed. Michigan-Indiana, Motorstadt, Western Michigan, and, back then, the Chicago Region was in the series. The last event WMR ever hosted at Nothdruft was just the following weekend. It was the Holiday on Wheels autocross on July 2, 1978 and we were post event guests at Bob Durren's home on Lake Michigan for a pool party. It was also this writer's very first road course event in my 914.

Bob Durren passed away in 1991 and the property was sold to a automobile enthusiast bar owner from Chicago named Dan Schnitta. The next part of the story continues next month beginning at his tavern near Wrigley Field named **The Gingerman**.

Tech Tactics is a biannual event hosted by PCA at two of Porsche Cars North America's training facilities and parts warehouses, one in Southern California and the other in Pennsylvania. At every Tech Tactics, attendees receive access to dealer technician training facilities that are normally off limits to the public, are treated to several presentations by Porsche experts and PCNA employees covering various subjects, and can get up close to Porsche's newest models, some of which are not yet available.



Each Tech Tactics event is spread over two days, and each day of programming is the same. Attendees may choose to attend either Saturday or Sunday.

Tech Tactics West always takes place the Saturday and Sunday after the Los Angeles International Auto Show opens to the public and is located at Porsche's brand-new, shared parts and training facility in Eastvale, CA.

Tech Tactics East happens in Easton, Pennsylvania on a Saturday and Sunday in late February or early March, at PCNA's Northeastern parts warehouse and training facility.
