

PORSCHE CLUB OF AMERICA

Last month's article ended at the Gingerman Tavern in Chicago owned by Dan Schnitta. With the help of articles by CAR and DRIVER writer John Phillips, Dan's friend, Don Patterson, from the Untold Stories: Billiards History blogspot, and with talking to Dan himself, the story continues.

In college, Schnitta saw a Porsche 356C in a car magazine. "My dream was to go to Stuttgart to buy that car," he recalls. "So, in 1965, a friend and I got in a '41 Mercury, and we found a liquor store, bought a bottle of whiskey, drank it, and puked on the car. It was two degrees in Chicago. We headed toward New Orleans, and the puke didn't thaw until Kentucky." In New Orleans, the pair boarded a freighter bound for Le Havre, France, "except the captain didn't tell us we were going to Central America first," he recalls. "That took three months. I was the galley boy. But once I got to Europe, I found work doing laundry for U.S. soldiers in Dachau. It was fun. The soldiers gave me free beer. Then I drove to



Nice and found a church with a sign that said, 'Free Cookies'—wow, a free meal, so in I went. The priest hired me as a handyman, then one day told me I was riding my motorcycle too fast and drinking too much. He said, 'You might want to move on.'"

Sans 356C, Schnitta returned to the U.S., arriving in Philly in 1966. "In a bookstore, there was an ad for the 'unexpurgated edition of The Ginger Man, by J.P. Donleavy.' It sounded racy. I read it all through the night on the bus headed back to Chicago. The book's main character is Sebastian Dangerfield, a redheaded American ex-pat who finds himself in a series of debaucherous misadventures in Ireland. And I thought, 'Wow, he's me. That's me.'"


Once home, Schnitta applied to the Peace Corps but was rejected as "too much of a bounder," so he went into real estate. "A guy told me bars were good investments. So I found one [in 1975], a flat-iron building that had been owned

by a woman selling everything from prostitutes to heroin. When I bought it, the cops told me to wait a year before reopening, to get rid of the 'children of the night.' They said, 'We don't even want you to smile in there.' The bar was next to the Metro Theatre, and I thought, 'Beautiful actresses will come into my place!' Some did, but mostly guys-Leonard Nimoy, John Malkovich, Gary Sinise. Mainly had an artsy and reflective clientele. When they came in all revved up and tipsy after a ballgame, I put on classical music. Calmed them right down," Still, the children of the night sometimes returned.



with dire consequences. "A guy went into the men's room and shot his head off. Business wasn't so good that evening. Later in the week, I told a drunk he couldn't come in. He jammed his hand through the front window, cut his arteries, almost bled to death. The cops arrived and said, 'Schnitta, you gotta cut this shit out.' I said, 'I didn't let him in.' The cop said, 'Yeah, well, that's two in one week.' I installed big windows so the cops could see what was going on inside. They liked that."

The year is 1986 and Dan was at work behind the bar at his GingerMan Tavern. He is staring at a stack of unpaid bills and a empty bar. He is trying to decide whether to pull the plug and call it quits or try to keep the doors open, when two gentleman in suits walk in and order a couple drinks. Dan goes about his business as the two gentleman walk around the bar pointing and talking. The two men then approach Dan after their drinks and tell Dan they have a proposition for him. The proposition is that they'll pay him a large sum of money and completely remodel his bar if he closes for a month or so, while they shoot scenes for a movie. Dan has little reason to ask many questions other then where do I sign. Dan watches as his bar is remodeled and transformed into a movie set. The day comes when they're ready for shooting the scenes and much to Dan's surprise, he shows up to find Paul Newman and Tom Cruise on the



set. Production comes to an end and Dan now has a newly remodeled bar that was used as a movie set. He reopens to a new clientele and business is good, the bills are paid and the bar is making money. Dan is thinking life could get no better.

Several months later, his manger calls him all excited and asks Dan what should he do, he has arrived to find hundreds of people standing in line all the way down the block and waiting for the bar to open. "The Color of Money" has just opened in theaters and the GingerMan Tavern is now one of Chicago's main attractions. Dan is quick to recognize the opportunity and applies a cover charge and takes it one step further, the table that Newman and Cruise played on is roped off and a significant addition charge is applied to playing on "The Table". The moral of the story can best be summed up as: Even in your darkest hour, one never knows when financial good fortune will walk through your door, but when it does, you had better have a good understanding of "The Color of Money".

After the movie was released in 1986, Schnitta's bar business boomed, and he began buying cars, initially a BMW 320i built by Steve Dinan for SCCA racing. "Before my first real race at Elkhart Lake, my mom said, 'Listen, take it easy, okay?' I said, 'I think I'll go as fast as I possibly can.' Among Schnitta's acquisitions his favorites include an 'O2 Honda


S2000; a '67 Jag XKE; an '06 Lotus Elise; an '87 Lotus Esprit; a '68 Corvette GT1 racer; a '94 Mazda RX-7 and an '05 RX-8; an '06 Nissan 350Z; an '05 Porsche Boxster S; a '57 MGA; a '98 Formula Mazda; a '70 Porsche 911 RS that Schnitta painted French pink ("I love that car, they'll bury me in that car"); two BMW M3s—an '02 and an '08 ("I loaned the first one to my daughter, who never gave it back, so now I have two"); a '97 Formula Ford; a '71 Porsche 911 Targa; and, in Costa Rica, a much-loved '06 Toyota Terios ("top speed around 65 mph").

Dan decided in 2012 to sell the Gingerman to Metro Theater owner, Joe Shananhan, and move to South Haven, Michigan and devoted full time to his next project also accorded the Gingerman name. That story next month. "Both Gingerman and Metro have contributed to a Wrigleyville spark that is being drowned out by more modern establishments," said Schnitta in a press release. "Joe understands the revelry necessary to carry on that spirit." That's a kind way of saying the Gingerman is one of the only tolerable bars in that neck of the woods. You can find the GingerMan Tavern at 3740 N. Clark Street, in Chicago.

A RARE FIND

FROM THE EDITOR



Awhile ago I acquired a stack of vintage LP's. To my surprise one cover contained some none music related information. You might get a chuckle out of the statements below. It was just a reprint in mediocre quality, but you can see the year on the stamp.

Dear Sir:

We're writing this letter to you today because we want to help you get your money out of your Model T.

It's still as good a car as it was the day the new Model A Ford was announced and there's no need to sacrife it.

The Model T Ford is still used by more people than any other automobile. Eight million are in active service right now and many of them can be driven one. two, three and five years and even longer.

Bring your car to us and let us look it over. You'll be surprised to see how little it costs to put it in tip-top shape.

New fenders, for instance, cost from \$3.50 to \$5.00 each, with a labor charge of \$1.00 to \$2.50. Tuning up the motor and replacing commutator case, brush and vibrator points costs only \$1.00, with a small charge for material. Brake shoes can be installed and emergency brakes equalized for a labor charge of only \$1.25. A labor charge of \$4.00 to \$5.00 will cover the overhauling of the front axle, rebushing

springs and spring perches, and straightening, aligning and adjusting wheels.

The labor charge for overhauling the average rear axle runs from \$5.75 to \$7.00. Grinding valves and cleaning carbon can be done for \$3.00 to \$4.00.

A set of four new pistons and rings cost only \$7.00. For a labor charge of \$20 to \$25.00 you can have your motor and transmission completely overhauled. Parts are extra.


