According to PCA it was the largest Parade to date, with over 1000 Porsches and over 3000 registrants. 

Gas Saving Tips from Euro Autowerks

Let's begin with just a few good rules to follow.

- Make sure your car is in proper tune.
- Check your tire pressure and keep them set to the proper pressure.
- Avoid buying gas if the delivery truck is there. The filling of the station tank stirs up sediment and we don't want that in our fuel tanks.
- Fill up in the morning since as with any liquid, fuel expands with heat.
- Fill up early in the week. Use an app to find the best price in your area. Top up no later than mid-week as we all know the price of gas goes up on weekends and holidays.
- Do not buy gas at highway exits. Their prices are normally higher.
- Stop filling when the pump clicks off the first time. Fuel tank venting systems do not like over-filled fuel tanks.



Here are a few good gas saving tips that you can expand on. Make saving gas a game and challenge yourself to see how well you can do.

- Drive at a constant speed. Acceleration and deceleration will waste fuel.
- Use your cruise control.
- If you become proficient at a steady pedal, you can save more money by not using cruise control. This takes discipline. For example, without Cruise hold a steady pedal while going up hill and let your speed drop as it will. When going down hill let it gain a few MPH while holding steady.
- Slowdown 5-10 MPH depending upon how fast you drive. For example, I dropped my highway speed from 85 to 75 which netted me 1.5 mph in my Ram truck.
- Use your on-board fuel economy gauge. Find the sweet spot for your car and adjust you driving habits to keep it at the highest number possible.
- Avoid Idle Time. You can burn a gallon an hour just sitting and it nets you "O" MPG.
- Time traffic lights.
- Back off in heavy traffic and try to maintain a steady speed. It takes more fuel to get a car moving than it does to keep it rolling.
- Avoid aggressive driving Save that for the Porsche.
- Coast 100 yards or so more when coming to a stop or turn.
- Keep your car waxed and the windows up. Dirty cars and windows down increase drag which decreases fuel mileage.

These are just a few tips, add your own and see how well you can do.

Now that you are saving fuel all week, get that Porsche out and have fun. Hammer it and use up all the fuel you saved during the week. After all, that's why you bought it.

Drive safe and enjoy this summer weather. And remember, a gallon of gas is cheaper than a pound of hamburger!



PORSCHE PANACHE VIA JERRY BERTA

During the 1970's and into the 1980's WMR held an event called "Holiday On Wheels". It packed a concours, rally, and an autocross over two days of the July 4th weekend. Forty years ago this year, popular local artist, Jerry Berta, created some of the funkiest and

unique event trophies you could ever have imagined. This is how they were described in the July 1982 Über Alles. "Using pictures and drawings as inspirations for his characterization of the Porsche 356 Coupe, Jerry modeled our Holiday on Wheels trophies. 911's, 914's, 924's.... did not have the 'looks' necessary to characterize, according to Jerry. Score another one for the tubs!"

Berta also famously had a love for old diners which led to him creating Rosie's diner in Rockford. He moved the diner car used in the old Bounty paper towel

TV commercials to Rockford and restored it back into a working restaurant opening in the mid 1990's. Popular for many years, even hosting weekly crusin-ins. New ownership in 2006 with many updated ideas failed to keep the diner profitable and Rosie's closed
