



A LOOK BACK - MEXICAN VIAJE "ON YOUR OWN!"

On October 15, 1961, 32 PCA Porsches from 21 states converged on Eagle Pass, Texas, to begin the 16-day Viaje (or trip) de Mexico. It was organized by Earl Kirschbaum, who we met in the last two issues. And this trip was also referenced in the Über Alles article about Al Sabo in April 2021. Here is the text from Earl's event flyer and portions of trip reports by two attending PCAers, Ethel Evans and Bill Miller.

"Well, here we go! The FIRST PCA Viaje de Mexico, a national PCA event is all set. Are YOU going to be among this first lucky group? Total entries will be limited to 50 Porsches, so read on and then get your Entry form in on time.

Join with other PCAers in driving south-of-the-border through fabulous Mexico. You'll have 4 marvelous days and nights in glamorous Mexico City...be entertained by the Sports Car Clubs of Mexico...shop in the world-famous Mexican stores...see native costumes and dances.

In Acapulco, you'll live in luxury at the famous Hotel Pierre Marques with swimming pools and the soft blue Pacific for your delight. See the Bull-fights, shop for fabulous Mexican silver-craft and other native products.

Here are some facts and figures.

Cost per couple \$250.00 Cost per single \$150.00

This includes rooms in 1st class Hotels or Motels and 3 meals per day for 13 nights and 14 days. EXCEPTION: 3 dinners and 4 lunches in Mexico City and 2 lunches in Acapulco are ADDITIONAL. Other than that, this is a "package-deal" with all reservations and arrangements made for you.

Part of the way, you can drive ON YOUR OWN and part of the way, you will CARAVAN in a group.

The Tour will be guided by Melanie Heims, Secretary of PCA Arizona Region and Earl Kirschbaum, Past President PCA. Melanie has lived for many years in Mexico and is practically a native. Earl has toured through Mexico several times...and knows the ropes.

Here is a brief Itinerary...showing the NIGHT stops.

October 16: Mondova, Mexico October 17: San Louis Potisto October 18, 19, 20, 21: Mexico City October 22, 23, 24: Acapulco

October 25: Taxco

October 26, 27: San Jose de Purua

October 28: Guadalajara

From there, wind your various ways homeward or tour some more—but on your own.

Passports are not needed for Mexico for a U.S. Citizen. You do need a Tourist Permit ... get this at the border.

Be sure to get shots for Smallpox. This is compulsory. Your own medic will do this and issue an International Health Certificate. U.S. Insurance is not valid in Mexico so it's a good idea to buy Mexican Car Insurance at the border. These and other incidentals will run about \$40 total. Tourists are allowed to bring back DUTY FREE about \$500 worth of purchases per person.

"So we entered Mexico, with its miles of roadway stretching to the horizon, and cacti as far as the eye could see, and on either side, mountains. Monclova, Matehoula, San Luis Potosi, Mexico City proved just as exciting as their names. How VIP can PCA be? Welcoming dignitaries met us at the gates of their cities, or greeted us as we dined. Police escorts took us through city traffic.

(Will we ever forget the Mariachis, the girls' Bugle Band, the costumes, the dancing, or the pageantry?) The red carpet unrolled before us. That was not just traveling, but a wonderful way of life!

Traveling in a group you learn to listen for the Porsche purr of the engines as they rendezvous. But there was one who made our journey even more carefree. Nic Mattlinger of PoAC (Porsche of America Corporation) was always coming along behind us, car loaded with spare parts, his hands skillful and his willingness exceedingly great. No straggler was left by the wayside. There were, fortunately, no major needs, but at each stop he was always available and ready to listen to and correct all Porsche problems."

"Celebrity welcome for tour in Guadalajara; sweep races 1,2,3"

"On Saturday, October 28, at 4:30 o'clock, we were all parked at the curb before the American Motel, just outside Los Arcos, the gate to the City of Guadalajara. After counting noses and gossiping about the drive from Morelia to Guadalajara, we were instructed by officials of the Automovilistica de Jalisco to proceed to Los Arcos.

At the arch we were joined by a police escort and all the Classic Cars which also appeared in the parade. Among those oldsters were several very old Fords and at least one ancient Dodge in beautiful condition.

To honor the Mexican Flag, a Signal Red Porsche led the Parade, followed immediately by a white one and then a green one. Also in the parade were Austin-Healeys, Volvos, Fiats, Renault Gordinis, Sunbeam Alpines, modified Volkswagens, and others driven by members of the various sports car clubs.

Sunday morning we were guided to the race track and allowed to familiarize ourselves with the layout. There were several exciting races for small cars earlier and the race for Porsches was scheduled for 1:30 pm. The small cars put on a really good show, but the competition was doubly exciting when we realized that none of the Mexican competitors used roll bars or seat belts. They did, however, wear crash helmets.

The officials decided to divide the Porsches into 2 races, the first one for 1600 Normals only. In that 6 lap race, total distance 37 km, or 22.9 miles, the first place went to Claud Gilmore, Alamogordo, NM, with a time of 14 min and 21 sec. In second place was Al Sabo of Kalamazoo, Mich., and in third was Earl Kirschbaum, recently moved to Mesa, Arizona.

The last race of the day was for Porsche 1600 Supers and Super 90's, and any Mexican drivers who cared to enter. The Mexican cars included 2 modified Volvos and a modified Alpine. For this race we had a Le Mans type start for the 5 Porsches and 3 Mexican entries. In first position and first off when the flag was dropped was the Alpine, second off and in second position was a Super 90, after which came Dick Bena of St. Louis in a 1600 Super Roadster, one of the highly modified Volvos, Goodwin Stoddard in a 1600 Super Roadster(not believed related to Chuck Stoddard), Don Communale in a Super 90 Coupe, and Harold Kuever in a 1600 Super Coupe followed by the other Volvo. The Alpine was passed by the first Super 90 just before they reached the first 180 degree turn. Behind them things were not going so well; the modified Volvo was pushing Dick Bena so hard that they both went too deep into the first turn and both spun, slowing up the rest of the field and giving the first Super 90 an unbeatable lead. The winning Super 90, driven by Bill Miller, Asheboro, NC, had a time of 13 min, 26 sec, average speed of 52.5 mph, fastest lap 54.5 mph. Second place went to Goodwin Stoddard and third place to Dick Bena."
