



End of Summer Fun Run at Grattan Raceway Park!



Have you ever taken your car out on a country road to see how fast you could go but only lasted a few seconds because you were worried something might go wrong?

In 1999, a friend pulled into my driveway with this cool white 86 Porsche 944 that looked new. I had always been a Chevy guy with Camaros and Corvettes, but when he gave me a ride and let me drive this fast great-handling car, I had to get one. In Traverse City at that time, there were not a lot of Porsches in the area. But as luck would have it! I came across this Guards red 87 944 in front of a doctor's office with a for sale sign, Bingo! I now was a proud owner of a PORSCHE.


So we would drive through beautiful Leelanau county, which is northwest of Traverse City with all its twisting country roads. Yes, we would get the urge to see what the cars could do, mindful of too many bad things that could happen. So in 2000, we found that the Western Michigan Region Porsche Club had a drivers education event on a closed road course track (Grattan).

We joined the Club and went to our first Drivers Education Event and never looked back as we learned how to handle our cars at controlled speeds and have a new respect for these fine-handling machines. Now when I go for a ride on the back roads, I can enjoy the scenery knowing what my car can do.

If you decide to sign up for the End of Summer Fun Run Drivers Education event this September 9th & 10th for the first time, here is what to expect:

You arrive and sign in at the Tech barn, then go through a final tech inspection of your vehicle.

Soon after, there is a driver's meeting to familiarize everyone with the track and rules for the day. You will be assigned an instructor who will get to know you and your car.



As a first-year student or novice, you will head to classroom sessions for instruction with our chief driving instructor. Then, the student novice group will go out on the track with their instructor. Throughout the first day, there will be more classroom and track time with your instructor. On the second day, after your instructor's evaluation, you will be allowed to apply your newfound skills and drive on your own.

Common questions:

Do I need race tires? No, we're not racing. All-season or summer tires will work fine.

What about passing another car or one passing me? Whether it's your first time or you are a seasoned driver, passing is only allowed with a wave by you or the other driver in designated areas of the track.

Am I out driving along much more experienced drivers? No, there are 4 run groups in which every driver is assigned according to their experience level.

I hope this gives you a better idea about Driver's Education. And if I do see you at our event, a word of caution, it can be very addictive.

ENTHUSIAST OF THE YEAR

During 2022 we were able to have typical year of events after being limited in 2020 & 2021. In 2022 we had 236 members participate in at least 1 of 17 events that we held. Of the 236, 40 were new members that joined the club in 2021 or 2022.

Every year WMR selects an Enthusiast of the Year and a New Member Enthusiast of the year using a standard point system based on attendance to WMR events and newsletter involvement. The Enthusiast of the Year has their name engraved on a pin that is added to the roving trophy that they get to keep for the year. The New Member Enthusiast of the year will receive a name tag that has the award engraved on it along with their name.

In addition, this year the Board has decided to award a "Lifetime Enthusiast" award to anyone that has receive the Enthusiast of the Year award 3 time. We also decide to make the Lifetime award retroactive back to 1994. As a result, we are awarding it to:

Amber Door - 6 time Enthusiast of the Year
Craig & Chris Ackerman - 3 time Enthusiast of the Year
Jerry Arens - 3 time Enthusiast of the Year
Dan Phillips - 3 time Enthusiast of the Year

Once you've earned Lifetime Enthusiast you will be recognized every year but will not be selected Enthusiast of the Year. Once you're selected as an Enthusiast you cannot be selected again for the following two years.

The 2022 Enthusiast of the year with 260 points is **Chris Thorpe** (see cover).

For the 2022 New Member Enthusiast of the year we had a 3 way tie with 60 points: **Roger & Marcia Huff, Jason Israels**


