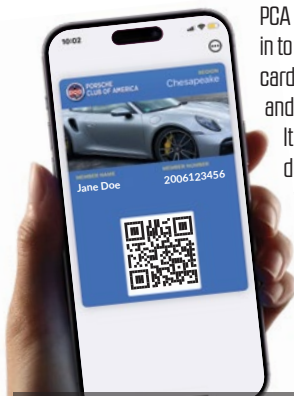

Mark your calendar to join us on Saturday, May 18 for our 11th Annual Sporting Clays Shoot off at the Blendon Pines Gun Club.

Up for a little outdoor "golf with a gun"? Then plan to come out for this event. For those unfamiliar with Sporting Clays it is a form of clay pigeon shooting on a course that consists of shooting stations "holes" in natural terrain. Unlike traditional skeet shooting sporting clays simulates the unpredictability of live-quarry shooting, offering a great variety of trajectories, angles, speeds, elevations, and distances. Trust is when we say -- No skill or previous shooting experience is required to participate and have fun.

This event is outside along a groomed trail - Rain or shine. As part of the trail is in the woods even in the rain there is a lot of protection from the weather. Please wear appropriate clothing and shoes. Eye and ear protection is REQUIRED. Regular glasses/sunglasses are adequate, and they do have some protective eye wear available, but if it's busy they may run out. They also sell earplugs. Guns are available to rent for 10.00 - 15.00 (2 people can share 1 gun) and of course ammunition is available for sale.

The cash cost (2.00 higher for credit card use) will be 29.00. Shells will be approximately 23.00 for 2 boxes. You are more than welcome to bring your own shotgun and shells. Additionally, if you would like to participate, but are unsure about the walking distance let us know.

You are always welcome to join us to spectate and wander through the woods with us and just hang out. More to come via web and e-blast regarding a potential lunch on your own to follow.

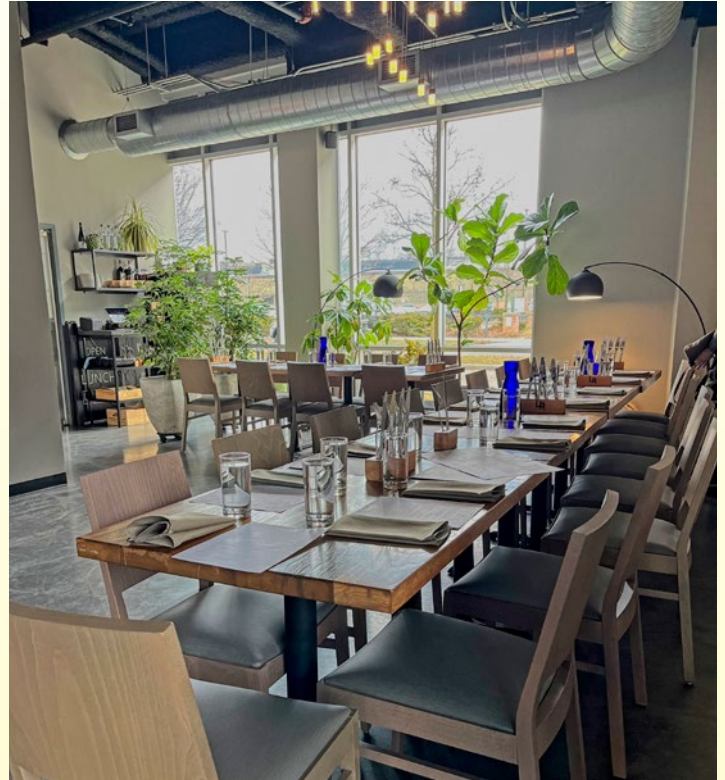

END OF SUMMER FUN RUN

It is spring, then summer, and before you know it, the biggest event of the year will be upon us. Sorry to make the time fly any faster than it already does.

This year's End of Summer Fun Run at Grattan Speedway will run on Saturday and Sunday, September 7th-8th. It's never too early to plan and ensure your spot, the number of participants is limited in all groups. First-time students will have a more satisfying track experience with the new class of national PCA instructors.

If you are attending the event for the first time, here is what you can expect:

Upon your arrival, you'll need to sign in at the Tech Barn and undergo a final inspection of your vehicle. There will be a driver meeting to familiarize everyone with the track and rules for the day. You'll then meet your in-car instructor, who will have already contacted you.

As a first-year student or novice, your first time on track with the instructor will be at a slower speed without a helmet. It will help you to familiarize yourself with the track and ensure a safe and satisfying driving experience. Then, there will be classroom sessions with our Chief Driving Instructor.

Throughout the first day, you will have more classroom and track time with your instructor. On the second day, after your instructor's evaluation, you will be allowed to apply your newfound skills and drive on your own.

Here are some common questions you may have about driving:

1. Can I use my regular tires, and will it wear them out? Yes, you can use any all-season or summer tires, and they won't wear out excessively.
2. Do I need a helmet? Yes, a Helmet with a Snell rating SA/M/K 2015 or newer.

3. What about passing another car or one passing me? Whether it's your first time or you are a seasoned driver, passing is only allowed in designated areas with a point by you or the other driver.
4. Am I driving with much more experienced drivers? No, there are four run groups, and every driver is assessed according to their experience level.

I hope this gives you a better idea about Drivers Education and how you can enjoy your car in a controlled and safe environment.
